- "peace with God" must come before the "peace from God".

"Peace with God"

Rom 5:1

- 1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- "the tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and therefore fearing nothing from God and content with its earthly lot, of whatsoever sort that is."

Peace originates in the person of God -

- 1. God is always in a state of perfect peace.
- 2. God is never in turmoil, He is never under stress, worried, anxious, fearful, unsure, or threatened. He is always perfectly calm, tranquil, and content.
- 3. God is never surprised by something that would rattle His peace.
- 4. God never makes a bad decision to upset His peace.
- 5. God never has any doubts.

God's peace provides stability. It enables a believer to remain calm and not fluctuate in any & all adverse circumstances.



What destroys peace?


Sin – your lack of trust in God for every situation and circumstance.

- 3. The individual, specific promises of God's Word.
- If I am trusting God in those 3 areas, then I am walking in the Spirit, I am controlled with the Spirit and as a result I will experience the peace of God.


Gal 5:22-23

"Grace"

$\chi \alpha \rho \iota \sigma$ – undeserved favor or benefit.

- 1. **Grace** is God acting freely, according to His own nature of love, with no promises or obligations to fulfill.
- 2. **Grace** therefore is uncaused in those who receive it; its cause lies wholly in the giver God.
- The "grace given for justification" must come before the "grace given for sanctification".

Grace given for justification.

Rom 3:24

24 being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

Eph 2:8-9

- 8 For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God;
- 9 not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

2 Cor 9:8

- 8 And God is able to make all grace abound to you,
- Grace provides strength enables a believer to endure and persevere under adverse circumstances.

2 Cor 12:9-10

4 Applications of 2 Thessalonians:

- 1. What you believe about prophecy does have a profound impact on your life.
- 2. False teaching, as the believers at Thessalonica received, can wreak havoc in a church.
- 3. The only way God will deal with a church which is acting unbiblical is by that church putting itself under the authority of the Word to do God's will. Any other way will put the authority in man's flesh to do the Devil's will.
- 4. Suffering and persecution can destabilize a believer unless he/she is grounded in the peace and grace of God.
