The Messianic Psalms

2; 8; 16; 22; 27; 34; 35; 40; 41; 45; 68; 69; 82; 86; 102; 109; 110; 118

1. They are called “Messianic” because they make reference to the Messiah.
2. A Messianic psalm is a psalm that makes predictions about the Messiah.
 - His birth.
 - His person - that He would be fully God and fully man in one person.
 - His life.
 - His death, burial, and resurrection.
 - His ascension into heaven.
 - His priestly ministry.
 - His second coming.
 - His victory over His enemies.
 - His universal reign on the earth.

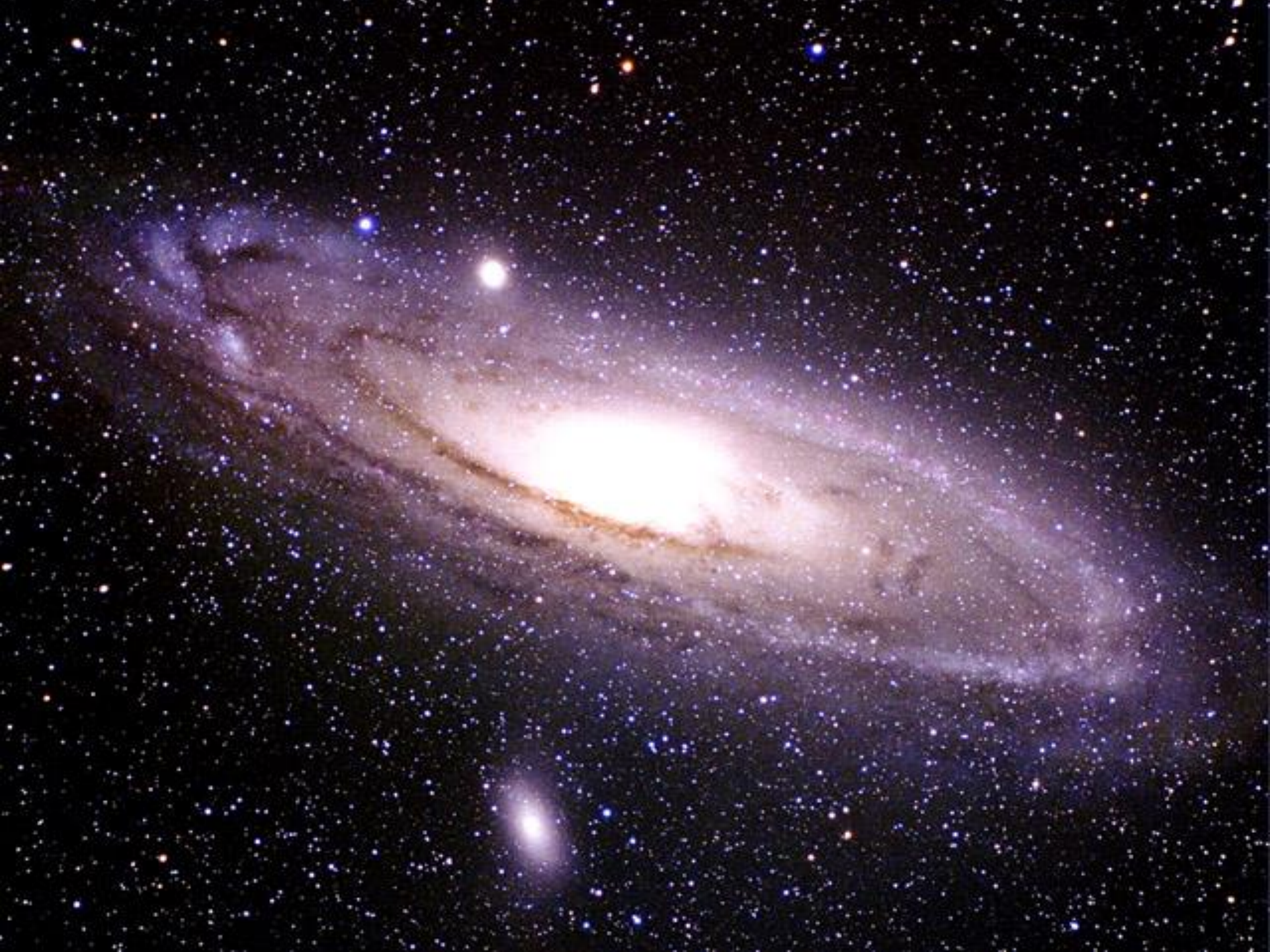

The sheer vastness of outer space and the coordination of it all is mind boggling.

- If you could travel at the speed of light, 186,000 miles per second, it would take you 8 minutes to get to the sun.
- To go from the sun to the center of the Milky Way would take about 33,000 years.
- The Milky Way belongs to a group of some 20 galaxies known as the Local Group. To cross that group, you'd have to travel for 2 million years.
- The Local Group belongs to the Virgo Cluster, part of an even larger Local Supercluster, which is a half-billion light years across. To cross the entire universe as we know it would take you 20 billion light years

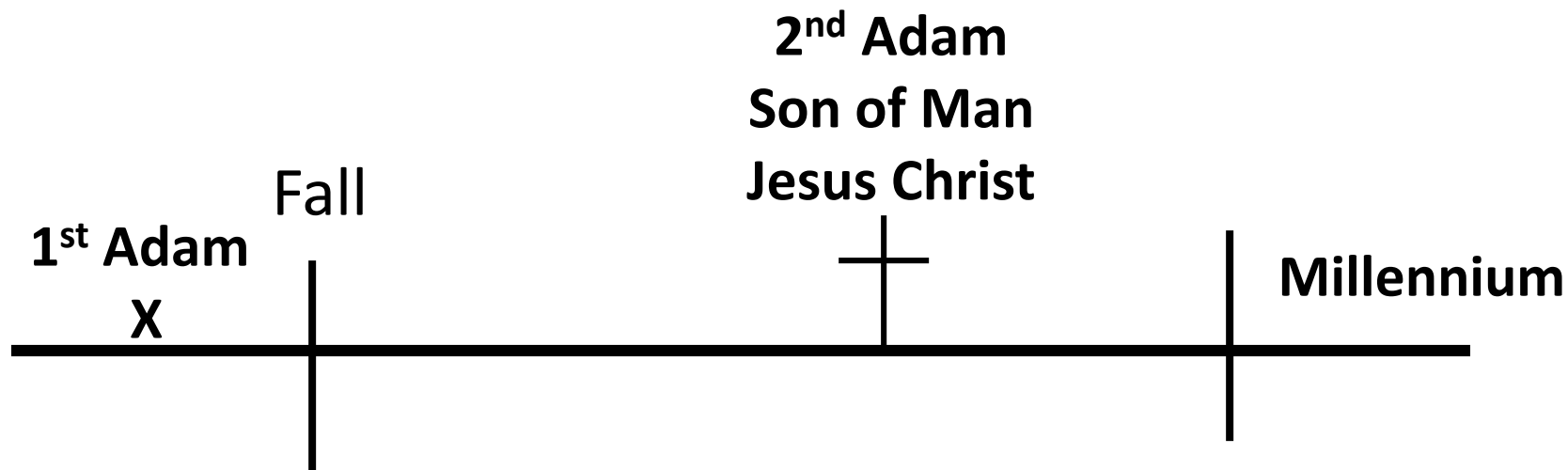
Mark 10:42-45

Application

1. God's name (Yahweh) is majestic because He is the great "I AM" – He has always existed, He exists today, and He will always exist. Therefore all things depend on Him, and He depends on no one and nothing.
2. God's name is majestic (Adonai) because He is the sovereign creator and ruler over the entire universe.
3. God defeats his foes with the weakness of children, and he rules His world with the weakness of men.
4. Man therefore needs to come to God as a little child in his faith.
5. A baby who can only coo or babble or nurse has a supreme place in creation, just under God, and therefore bears witness to their place of dignity in creation. A baby holds the place of a human creation made in the image of the majestic God. If God's adversaries mistreat or disregard these little ones of high rank, and therefore blaspheme the majesty of God, they will face the full fury of God's wrath in judgment.

“You cannot starve the aged human and glorify the majesty of God.

You cannot dismember the unborn human and glorify the majesty of God.

You cannot gas the Jewish human and glorify the majesty of God.

You cannot lynch the black human and glorify the majesty of God.

You cannot treat human pregnancy like a disease and glorify the majesty of God.

You cannot treat the mixing of human races like a pestilence and glorify the majesty of God.

You cannot worship and glorify the majesty of God while treating his supreme creation with contempt.”

6. The most glorious display of the majesty of God's name is the coming and reign of the Messiah, the Son of Man, over creation.
7. All who belong to Jesus Christ will one day rule with Him over creation. We are brought to that position by Christ, who by becoming man (our human representative), lived a perfect life, died for our sins, rose from the dead, was triumphant over all God's enemies, and rules all creation to display the majesty of God.
