1. GOD CONTROLS YOUR TONGUE. (1)

- 1 The plans of the heart belong to man, But the answer of the tongue is from the Lord.
- Mr. President, when making a decision, you will look at all the issues, all the options, all the responsibilities, and all the consequences in order to compare them so that you can choose the right course. You will look deep into your mind, you will struggle with your feelings, and you will be determined in your will, but the final product that comes forth from your mouth belongs to God.

2. GOD KNOWS YOUR MOTIVES. (2)

2 All the ways of a man are clean in his own sight, But the Lord weighs the motives.

- If you only look at your outward actions, they may seem right to you Mr President, but your motives for doing them may be wrong, they may be corrupt, they may be deceitful, they may be anything but pure.
- The documents you sign into law, the treaties you sign with our enemies, the State of the Union speeches that you give to our nation may appear to be something different than the deceptive motives that lurk in your heart.
- Your greatest danger, Mr. President is not the deception from your staff, or a congressman, or a foreign leader. No, your greatest deception is self-deception.

- You will need to be constantly vigilant of your heart and the motives that emerge from it.

- Mr. President, the accomplishment of your plans for our country, will achieve their highest success when you commit them to the God of the universe.
- Your thousands of meetings you use to plan and strategize will go as far as and no further than the purposes of God.

- Your presidency and the legacy you leave will depend on your commitment to live a transparent, moral, upright, life of integrity, a presidency not marked by shady dealings, backdoor politics, cover-ups, crooked and fraudulent living, and immoral practices.

Sir Robert Grant (1779-1838)

Sir Robert Grant was born and died in India—a country that by this time had long played a major role in the British Empire. He was a public servant distinguishing himself in law, serving as a member of Parliament, judge, advocate general, and governor of Bombay (now Mumbai).

Grant's father Charles was a leader in the evangelical wing of the Church of England and also played an active civic role with William Wilberforce in the emancipation of African slaves in the British Empire. Robert was born in India when his father went there to negotiate an end to barriers set up against missions by the British East India Company
