2. 20,000 population.
3. Not a significant religious center.
4. Main god worshipped: Apollo
Others: Asclepias, Dionysus, Artemis
5. Known for their trade guilds (labor unions).

Church at Thyatira

1. Possible ways that was started:
 - Paul when he was in Ephesus.
 - Lydia – Acts 16:12-15.
2. Was pressured to join guilds to make a living.
3. Was out of existence by the end of the 2nd century having been swallowed up by the Montanist heresy.
4. Commended for 6 qualities:
 - Deeds
 - Love
 - Faith
 - Service
 - Perseverance
 - Growth

Jezebel

1. Jezebel, a Sidonian woman and Baal worshiper, and King Ahab (a Jewish king) were married. Baal, was a cruel, sensuous and revolting false god whose worship involved **sexual immorality and lewdness**.
2. King Ahab became involved in Baal worship. Ahab built a house to Baal in the capital city of Samaria and made an Asherah pole as a tool of pagan worship.

1 Kings 16:33

33 Ahab also made the Asherah. Thus Ahab did more to provoke the Lord God of Israel than all the kings of Israel who were before him.

3. After their marriage, **Jezebel cut off and killed many prophets** in Israel.

1 Kings 18:13

13 "Has it not been told to my master what I did when Jezebel killed the prophets of the Lord, that I hid a hundred prophets of the Lord by fifties in a cave, and provided them with bread and water?"

4. It was during the time of Ahab and Jezebel that Elijah was the prophet in Israel. Satan had his couple on the throne, but God had His man in the field, performing miracles and leading a revival against Baal-worship. The three-and-a-half-year drought that Elijah prayed for was part of God's judgment on the wickedness of the nation and its leaders.
5. After Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal and had them killed at Mt. Carmel (1 Kings 18), Jezebel issued a death threat against him (1 Kings 19:2). Despite hearing of the miraculous powers of the Lord, Jezebel **refused to repent** and swore on her gods that she would pursue Elijah relentlessly and take his life.

6. The queen went on to plot against Naboth, the innocent owner of a vineyard that Ahab coveted. **Jezebel had Naboth killed** so the king could confiscate his land (1 Kings 21).

7. Naboth's sons were also stoned to death, so there would be no heirs. (2 Kings 9:26)

8. She prodded her husband into **many other wicked acts:**

1 Kings 21:25

25 Surely there was no one like Ahab who sold himself to do evil in the sight of the Lord, because Jezebel his wife incited him.

9. Jezebel was into witchcraft and sorcery.

2 Kings 9:22

22 When Joram (Jezebel's son) saw Jehu, he said, "Is it peace, Jehu?"
And he answered, "What peace, so long as the harlotries of your mother Jezebel and her witchcrafts are so many?"

10. Ahab's death was predicted by the prophets Elijah and Micaiah (1 Kings 21:19; 22:28).

True to the prophecy, Ahab was killed in a battle with Syria. 2 Kings 9:30-37

Jezebel's gruesome death was also predicted by Elijah (1 Kings 21:23).

1 Kings 21:23

23 "Of Jezebel also has the Lord spoken, saying, 'The dogs will eat Jezebel in the district of Jezreel.'

2 Kings 9:30-37

- 30 When Jehu came to Jezreel, Jezebel heard of it, and she painted her eyes and adorned her head and looked out the window.
- 31 As Jehu entered the gate, she said, "Is it well, Zimri, your master's murderer?"
- 32 Then he lifted up his face to the window and said, "Who is on my side? Who?" And two or three officials looked down at him.
- 33 He said, "**Throw her down.**" So they threw her down, and some of her blood was sprinkled on the wall and on the horses, and he trampled her under foot.
- 34 When he came in, he ate and drank; and he said, "See now to this cursed woman and bury her, for she is a king's daughter."
- 35 They went to bury her, but they found nothing more of her than the skull and the feet and the palms of her hands.
- 36 Therefore they returned and told him. And he said, "This is the word of the Lord, which He spoke by His servant Elijah the Tishbite, saying, 'In the property of Jezreel the dogs shall eat the flesh of Jezebel;
- 37 and the corpse of Jezebel will be as dung on the face of the field in the property of Jezreel, so they cannot say, "This is Jezebel.'""

When Christians were confronted in the 3rd century for their compromise with the guilds, they replied, “this is the only way we can live” to which Tertullian, a Christian leader, looked them straight in the eyes and said, “Must you live? Must you?”.

- No, you don't have to live, and the ultimate service to our Lord is His ultimate claim upon a Christian's life.
- The ultimate loyalty we have is not to our physical life. Not to the kind of life that we must live here upon this earth.
- Our ultimate loyalty is to the Lord God, and if it means death then that's the expression of our ultimate loyalty. The idea you must do this because “that's the way it's done here,” is not a Christian idea at all.
- Our Lord does not leave any room for anyone who says, “Well I've got to live, so I have to do these things that are contrary to the word of God.

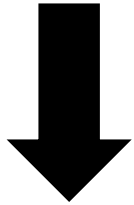
Dualism

1. The spirit is good, and the flesh is evil.
2. God is only interested in the spirit, He doesn't care about the body so it doesn't matter what you do with your body.
3. Dualism said the body is material, the body is dirt, the body is earthy, the body is flesh and the body is sinful and that's not going to change, and that's how it is. And the spirit is good and holy and righteous and as long as your spirit is committed to Christ and you're here worshiping Him in spirit, what you do in your body doesn't matter and so you can do both.
4. Therefore, according to Jezebel, it did not matter if believers "committed acts of immorality."
5. This gave believers in the church the license to sin.

Pluralism

1. Pluralism says there is more than one way, there are several ways.
2. Pluralism is based on Postmodernism which is the belief that there is no such thing as absolute truth.
3. That being the case, no religion can claim exclusivity of the truth. All religions are equal.
4. So it is ok to worship Jesus Christ in the morning, and worship Apollo in the afternoon, and Zeus in the evening.
5. Therefore, according to Jezebel, it did not matter if believers “ate things sacrificed to idols.”

Barna Research Survey -

The individuals surveyed considered themselves "born again", defined as:

1. Those who have made a personal commitment to Jesus Christ that is important in their life today.
2. Those who say they know they will go to Heaven after they die solely because they have confessed their sins and accepted Christ as their Savior.

1991 - 52% did not believe in absolute truth

1994 - 62% " " " "

2001 - 68% " " " "

2001 - 91% teens " " "

These same "born again" individuals:

40% - it does not matter what religious faith you follow because all faiths teach similar lessons about life.

77% - man is basically good by nature.

84% - in the matter of salvation, "God helps those who help themselves". They said it was the most well known verse in the Bible.

33% - we all pray to the same God and therefore faith in Christ is not absolutely necessary, so long as one is a good person.

55% - the Holy Spirit is merely a symbol of God's power and presence.

34% - Jesus sinned.

45% - deny Satan is a real being.

Labeled “nones” because they claim either no religious preference or no religion at all, their ranks have hit 46 million people. Much of the growth is among young people — one in three U.S. adults under 30 are now considered “nones”.

“We live in a time when confidence in the Word of God is getting rare. These are desperate times for the church. Many churches and pastors have forsaken God’s Word in favor of the words of men. Other churches have a reputation of honoring the Scriptures, but have largely pushed them aside in favor of programs, gimmicks, and entertainment. The Church Growth Movement and the Contemporary Christian Worship Movement offer user friendly techniques and styles to bring in large numbers of people, but into what? Churches where God’s Word is muzzled, sanitized, packaged, and spun until all that’s left is a combination of religious happy talk and self-help messages! Finding a church in which God’s Word is believed, taught, and confessed in its purity is not easy. What people want today is not the message of sin and grace found in the scriptural gospel of salvation for sinners through faith in Jesus Christ; they want to feel good about themselves, they want some self-help advice, and they want to be entertained.”

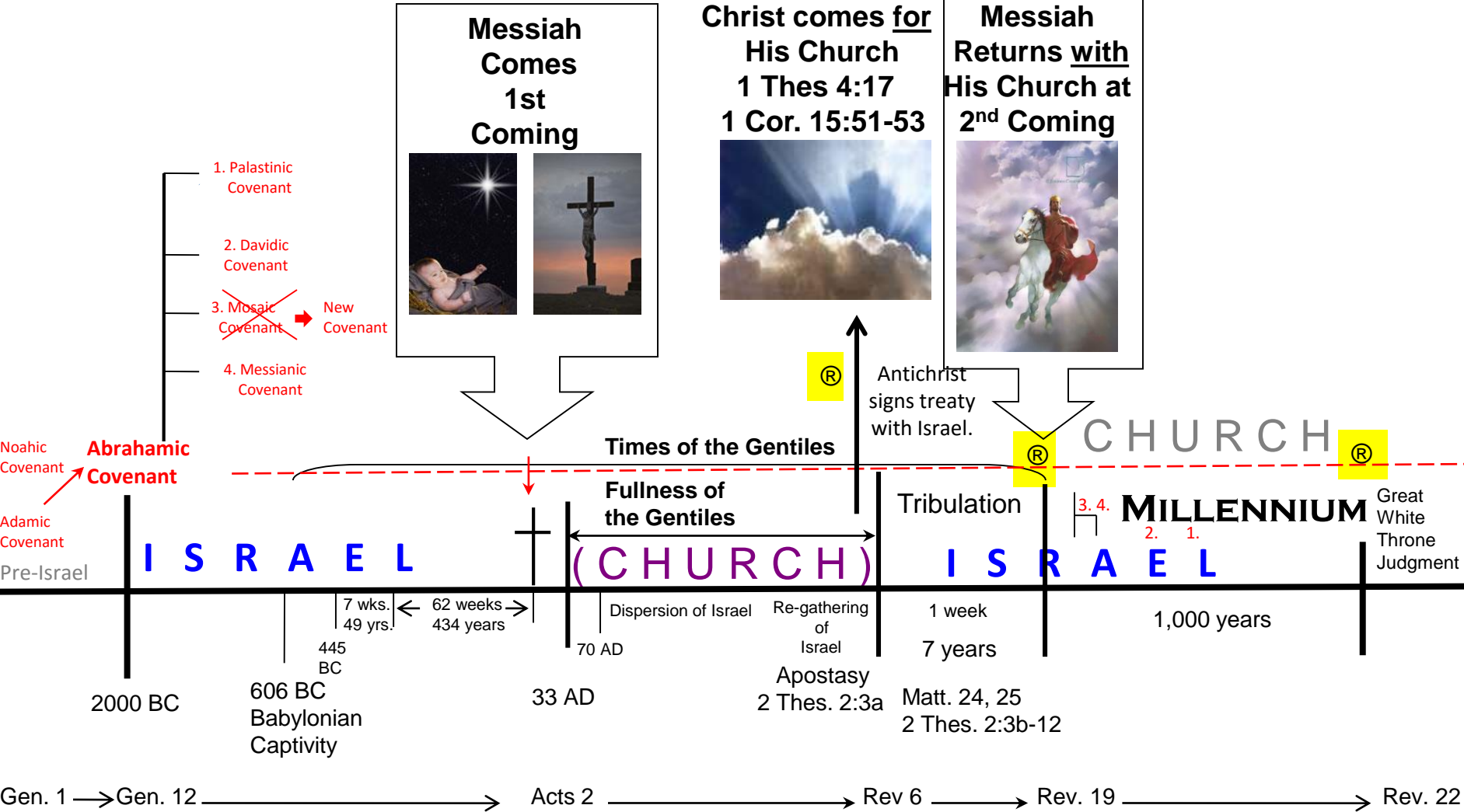

**Charles William Fry and Family
1838-1882**

Charles William Fry also helped the Christian Mission in Salisbury, and his family band accompanied Salvation Army founder William Booth on many evangelism campaigns.

“The First Bandmaster of the Salvation Army” was unveiled on a monument over his grave. On it was inscribed a verse Fry wrote:

***The former things are past,
And ended is the strife,
I’m safe home at last!
I live an endless life!***

The hymn that Charles William Fry wrote 1 year before his death and was published for the first time in the Salvation Army’s magazine, “War Cry”, on Dec. 29, 1881 was
