

7 Reasons for a Pre-Tribulation Rapture

I. The Nature of the Tribulation.

• It will be a time for the wrath of God upon the earth.

Rev 6:16-17

- 16 and they said to the mountains and to the rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the presence of Him who sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb;
- 17 for the great day of their wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"

It will be a time of God's dealing with Israel.

Jer 30:3-7

- 3 'For behold, days are coming,' declares the Lord, 'when I will restore the fortunes of My people Israel and Judah.' The Lord says, 'I will also bring them back to the land that I gave to their forefathers and they shall possess it.'"
- 4 Now these are the words which the Lord spoke concerning Israel and concerning Judah:

5 "For thus says the Lord,

I have heard a sound of terror,

Of dread, and there is no peace.

6 'Ask now, and see

If a male can give birth.

Why do I see every man

With his hands on his loins, as a woman in childbirth?

1 Thess 1:10



10 'Because you have kept the word of My perseverance, I also will keep you from the hour of testing, that hour which is about to come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth.



- 33 and He will put the sheep on His right, and the goats on the left.
- 34 "Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world

Rev 19:7-8,11,14


7 "Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready."


8 It was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.

14 And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, were following Him on white horses.



Dan 9:24-27

- 24 "Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sin, to make atonement for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy and to anoint the most holy place.
- 25 "So you are to know and discern that from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince there will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress.
- 26 "Then after the sixty-two weeks the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. And its end will come with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.
- 27 "And he will make a firm covenant with the many for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of abominations will come one who makes desolate, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on the one who makes desolate."



V. The Nature of Christ's Imminency. Acts 1:6-8

6 So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, "Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?"

7 He said to them, "It is not for you to know times $(\chi\rho\sigma\nu\sigma\sigma - \text{chronos} = \text{length of time})$ or epochs $(\kappa\alpha\iota\rho\sigma\sigma - \text{kairos} = \text{characteristics within a})$ length of time) which the Father has fixed by His own authority;

8 but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

V. The Nature of Christ's Imminency.

• We are to look for the Son – not signs.


1 Thess 1:10

10 and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, that is Jesus, who rescues us from the wrath to come.

*If a foreshadowing of Tribulational signs occurs they will be general and not specific and so it will be difficult to identify an exact time.

*There are no signs of the times because we are not in the time of the signs.

Old Testament View of Future Prophetic Events



- 10 As to this salvation, the prophets who prophesied of the grace that would come to you made careful searches and inquiries,
- 11 seeking to know what person or time the Spirit of Christ within them was indicating as He predicted the sufferings of Christ and the glories to follow.
- 12 It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves, but you, in these things which now have been announced to you through those who preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven things into which angels long to look.

Heb 1:1-2

- 1 God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways,
- 2 in these last days has spoken to us in His Son,

1 Peter 1:20-21

- 20 For He was foreknown before the foundation of the world, but has appeared in these last times for the sake of you
- 21 who through Him are believers in God,

2 Peter 3:3-4

- 3 Know this first of all, that in the last days mockers will come with their mocking, following after their own lusts,
- 4 and saying, "Where is the promise of His coming?

1 John 2:18

18 Children, it is the last hour; and just as you heard that antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have appeared; from this we know that it is the last hour.

Jude 17-18

- 17 But you, beloved, ought to remember the words that were spoken beforehand by the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 18 that they were saying to you, "In the last time there will be mockers, following after their own ungodly lusts.

1 Tim 4:1-3

- 1 But the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and doctrines of demons,
- 2 by means of the hypocrisy of liars seared in their own conscience as with a branding iron,
- 3 men who forbid marriage and advocate abstaining from foods which God has created to be gratefully shared in by those who believe and know the truth.

2 Tim 3:1-5

- 1 But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come.
- 2 For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy, 3 unloving, irreconcilable, malicious gossips, without self-control, brutal, haters of good, 4 treacherous, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, 5 holding to a form of godliness, although they have denied its power; Avoid such men as these.
