



# **Ashen** - Xλωροσ - form which the English words chlorophyll and chlorine come from.

- 1. refers to a sickly, pale, yellow-green color of decay.
- 2. a corpse in the advanced state of corruption.

## *4 terms which describe the place of the dead: 1. Sheol.*

\*Used 65 times in O.T. – 31 times as "hell"; 31 times as the "grave"; 3 times as the "pit".

#### 2. Hades.

\*Used 11 times. 10 meaning "hell"; 1 meaning "grave".

#### 3. Tartarous.

\*Used 1 time to denote the holding place for a group of demons.

#### 4. Gehenna.

\*Used 12 times in the N.T. Used as a geographical term and the final state of the unsaved.

#### Gen 6:1-4


- 6 Now it came about, when men began to multiply on the face of the land, and daughters were born to them,

- 4 The Nephilim were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of men, and they bore children to them.


#### Jude 6-7

#### **Death and Hades**

1. Christ is in charge of death and Hades. He invented them and uses them as tools in His sovereign plan for His glory.

#### **Rev 1:15**


- 18 and the living One; and I was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of death and of Hades.
- \*\*No one is getting out and no one is getting in unless Christ says so.
- 2. Hades takes in all that Death supplies.
- 3. Death takes the body, and Hades the spirit
- 4. Death and Hades will delivered up the dead who were in them. This the release of the spirit and soul of the unsaved from imprisonment in Hades to be joined with a bodily resurrection from the grave in order to stand before God in judgment. Then, having fulfilled His purposes, God will destroy them.

#### Rev 20:13-15

- 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one of them according to their deeds.
- 14 Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire.
- 15 And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

#### Hades has 2 compartments – Luke 16:19-28

- 19 "Now there was a rich man, and he habitually dressed in purple and fine linen, joyously living in splendor every day.
- 20 "And a poor man named Lazarus was laid at his gate, covered with sores,
- 21 and longing to be fed with the crumbs which were falling from the rich man's table; besides, even the dogs were coming and licking his sores.
- 22 "Now the poor man died and was carried away by the angels to Abraham's bosom; and the rich man also died and was buried.
- 23 "In Hades he lifted up his eyes, being in torment, and saw Abraham far away and Lazarus in his bosom.
- 24 "And he cried out and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus so that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool off my tongue, for I am in agony in this flame.'
- 25 "But Abraham said, 'Child, remember that during your life you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus bad things; but now he is being comforted here, and you are in agony.
- 26 'And besides all this, between us and you there is a great chasm fixed, so that those who wish to come over from here to you will not be able, and that none may cross over from there to us.'
- 27 "And he said, 'Then I beg you, father, that you send him to my father's house —
- 28 for I have five brothers in order that he may warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.'



#### Paradise -

## Luke 23:42-43

- 24 yet to remain on in the flesh is more necessary for your sake.


## 2 Cor 5:6-8

#### Where Do People Go When They Die?




### Eph 4:7-10

#### Ezek 5:15-17

- 15 'So it will be a reproach, a reviling, a warning and an object of horror to the nations who surround you when I execute judgments against you in anger, wrath and raging rebukes. I, the Lord, have spoken.
- 16 'When I send against them the deadly arrows of famine which were for the destruction of those whom I will send to destroy you, then I will also intensify the famine upon you and break the staff of bread.

#### Ezek 6:11-12

- 11 "Thus says the Lord God, 'Clap your hand, stamp your foot and say, "Alas, because of all the evil abominations of the house of Israel, which will fall by **sword**, **famine** and **plague**!
- 12 "He who is far off will die by the plague, and he who is near will fall by the sword, and he who remains and is besieged will die by the famine.

21 For thus says the Lord God, "How much more when I send My four severe judgments against Jerusalem: **sword, famine, wild beasts and plague** to cut off man and beast from it!

## Pestilence

**pes·ti·lence -** a fatal epidemic disease

- 1. Sanitation is diminished severely with war and famine and earthquakes. No medicine, living conditions descend to a primitive level.
- 2. Previously conquered diseases may also come back because they have mutated into strains which are no longer able to be prevented by their original vaccines, or cured by the originally created antibiotics, such as Tuberculosis, Malaria, Staphylococcus, etc.

- 3. The world knows from history the devastation of pestilence:
- Throughout human history, disease has killed people on a far more massive scale than war.
- More Union and Confederate soldiers died from disease during the Civil War than were killed in battle.
- 20 million people died in flu epidemics in World War I because as nations moved around they brought viruses with them.
- Six million more died of Typhus in World War I.
- Typhus killed 200 million people in four centuries.
- In the 14th century 1/4 to 1/3 of the people of the world died in the Black Plague, for a total of 60 million people.
- 35 million people had already died from the AIDS virus.
- 4. Added to all of this is biological weapons and chemical weapons, which we have in vast abundance which could wipe out millions of people. One quart of Sarin nerve gas can kill a million people. The size of a pinpoint can kill an entire Army battalion.

## Wild Beasts


- 1. With scarcity of food and depopulated areas, animals will begin moving into those populated areas that are left, looking for food. Snakes, bears, lions, tigers, alligators, etc.
- 2. However the most deadly creature on the face of the earth is the . . .
- Rats are annually responsible for the loss of billions of dollars of food in America alone and death all over the world.
- Rats infested with Bubonic Plague killed one third of the population of Europe in the fourteenth century.
- Rats can carry as many as thirty-five diseases at once.
- If ninety-seven percent of the rat population is exterminated in the given area, it will replace itself in less than a year.
- Rats have killed more people than all the wars of history and it always makes its home where men dwell.
- Rats produce 5 or more litters of 8 to ten babies each year.
- Their fleas are also said to have carried the Typhus which killed an estimated 200 million people in 4 centuries.

The picture being drawn is one of no escape. No matter which group or location a man finds himself in, there is a God-ordained judgment which will result in death.



"People say, "Peace," but the sword is coming. People cry, "Prosperity and plenty," but famine is coming. People boast of conquering disease by medical science, but pestilence is coming. Hunters complain of the disappearance of beasts to hunt, of game to pursue; but wild beasts will (by and by) multiply again, even in America, to the slaying of thousands upon thousands!"

## **Charles Wesley**

#### 1707-1788

December 18, 1707, Epworth, Lincolnshire, England. March 29, 1788, London, England. St. Marylebone Parish Church, London.

Charles Wesley wrote over 6,000 hymns.
In addition to hymn writing, Charles & John founded the movement which became the Methodist denomination.

➢ Charles Wesley and his brother, John, were unlikely candidates for rejoicing. Their lives were hard, too. As they went about spreading the gospel they encountered violent opposition. On one occasion, a mob nearly destroyed the house where they were staying and drove their horses into a pond. The people whom they converted were often harassed and persecuted. But they found great joy in serving Christ and called other Christians to do the same. Charles Wesley wrote these joyful words to this hymn that came out of his joyful life. The hymn that he wrote . . .

## **REJOICE, THE LORD IS KING**

 Rejoice, the Lord is king! Your Lord and king adore; Mortals give thanks and sing, and triumph evermore; Lift up your heart, lift up your voice; Rejoice, again I say, rejoice!

Jesus, the Savior, reigns, the God of truth and love;
When He had purged our stains He took His seat above;
Lift up your heart, lift up your voice;
Rejoice, again I say, rejoice!
