





- 14 The sky was split apart like a scroll when it is rolled up, and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.




2 Views - The Cause of "Natural Disasters"

"Doomsday science, how will the world end? On March 23, 1989 an asteroid a half mile across missed the earth by just seven hundred thousand miles. No one saw it coming. Who Will Escape His Wrath?

"kings of the earth" – positions in government/rulership

"the great men" – positions in industry/business

"the commanders" – positions in the military

"the rich" – positions of wealth

"the strong" – positions of influence

"every slave" - no position

"every free man" - no position

**God is no respecter of persons or positions. His wrath and judgment will fall on all who are not covered by the blood of the Lamb.

Five things about their reaction:

- 1. They want to die. They start praying . . . to Mother Nature. Their prayer is really a death wish.
- 2. They are struck with terror. Hide us. They know who is causing this God and the "Lamb".
- 3. They are unrepentant even though they know they are facing the day of God's wrath poured out against sin.
- 4. Their reaction will shut everything down no buying, no selling, no travel, no planning for the future the whole world comes to a standstill while it is shaking.
- 5. They seek to flee from God -
- Suicide (we have no hope)
- Annihilationism (we want no future existence)
- Hard hearts (we do not want to repentant)

Day of Christ


The Day of Christ is that period of time which begins with the rapture of the Church (1 Thess. 4:14-18) and includes the events which follow in heaven at the Judgment Seat of Christ and the Marriage of the Lamb (1 Cor. 1:8; 5:5; 2 Cor. 1:14; Phil. 1:6, 10; 2:16). The Day of Christ is a time of reward and blessing for the Church following the Rapture.


Day of the Lord

This is the period of time which begins with the Tribulation judgments and extends through the millennial reign of Christ on earth through the destruction of the heavens and the earth and into the ushering in of the new heavens and earth and the eternal state. 2 Peter includes everything from the Tribulation through the Millennium. This day begins as a thief (1 Thess. 5:2; 2 Pet. 3:10) being instituted by the signing of the peace treaty of Daniel 9:27 with mankind believing a new time of peace and safety has been ushered in.

Day of God


The events of the Day of God include the dissolving of the old heavens and the old earth (2 Pet. 3:10-14).

Isaac Watts (1674-1748)

Credited as the father of English hymnody for his vast outpouring of hymns, Isaac Watts (1674-1748) wrote some 600 hymns that were widely sung in England and America, some of which are included in many of today's mainline hymnals. However he was the center of controversy as his hymns became so popular that they were being used alongside the singing of the Psalms. The controversy split churches in England, who only sang the Psalms, and then skipped over the Atlantic and became a controversy here in America. Isaac Watts also produced the first collection of hymns intended for children, entitled Divine Songs Attempted in Easy Language for the Use of Children (1715). It sold 80,000 copies in one year. Although not intended for worship, Watts' verses aimed to teach children right behaviors. Watts' collections of hymns for children were widely used for many generations. Among the hymns he wrote for children is this hymn that speaks of creation and the providence of God. The wonderful hymn that he wrote was . . .

I SING THE MIGHTY POWER OF GOD

- I sing the mighty power of God, that made the mountains rise,
 That spread the flowing seas abroad, and built the lofty skies.
 I sing the wisdom that ordained the sun to rule the day;
 The moon shines full at God's command, and all the stars obey.
- 2. I sing the goodness of the Lord, who filled the earth with food, Who formed the creatures through the Word, and then pronounced them good.
