Examples in Scripture of believers crying out for God's vengeance on the wicked:

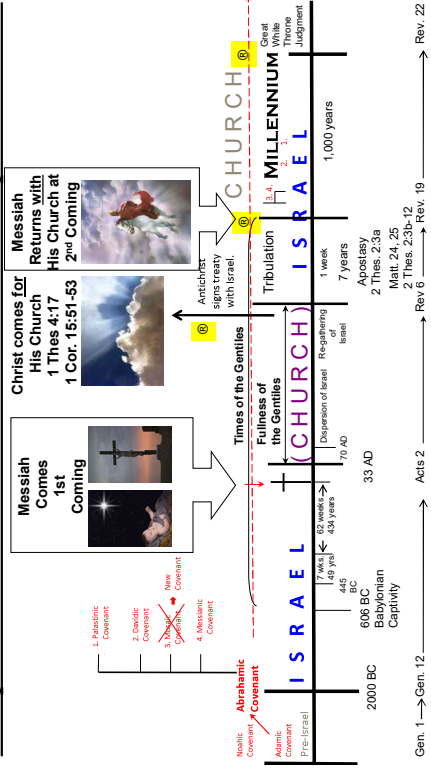

5 things the Antichrist and the Roman Confederacy will do to the harlot:

1. **They will hate her** – they hate her because she is competition. He has supported her for selfish reasons. She has brought him to a place of prominence. She has made him look good as a supporter of peace, unity, & love. But the tryst is over. The love affair is done. The rendezvous with the harlot is finished. He used her and now he will destroy her.
2. **They will make her desolate.** ἐρημωθ – to bring to nothing, to take out of existence. They will confiscate her wealth, her treasure, her power by which she has grown rich by extortion of the world's masses.
3. **They will make her naked.** She will lose everything that made her enticing – no scarlet and purple clothes, no gold, no precious stones, no pearls, no gold cup. They strip the system bare. She is exposed for what she really is – a bankrupt, morally corrupt system giving false security to those deceived into following her.

4. They will eat her flesh.

Just as Jezebel's flesh was eaten by dogs, so the Beast and his kings will murder the priests and priestesses involved in the hierarchy of her religious system.

5. They will burn her up with fire.

Κατακαίω – to burn down to the ground, burn-up.

The religious system of the world is left with nothing. Totally consumed. Religion and the city that was her capitol, Babylon, will totally disappear.

"heart" – καρδία - the seat and center of human life. The heart is the center of the personality, and it controls the intellect, emotions, and will.

- God's directive went to the mind and down into the heart.
- In the heart they could exercise their will and make a decision concerning what to do.
- In the present case, the Beast and RC make a decision (unknowingly) to do God's will by destroying the harlot.

• "His purpose" – His purpose is for them to unite.

- God always has a purpose for everything.
- They are delivering over their kingdoms. They are giving it all up and uniting behind the Antichrist.
- They think this is all their doing. They're making the plans, they're executing, and they're fulfilling their purpose.

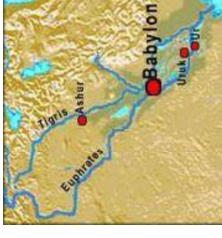

**August L. Storm
(1862–1914)**

August Ludvig Storm was born in Sweden. At 29 he was converted to Christ in a Salvation Army meeting in Stockholm. In grateful appreciation, he joined the Salvation Army Corp and became a preacher and teacher. Storm wrote this hymn in 1891. This hymn is based on a list he wrote, with 24 reasons for thanksgiving -- sources of tears as well as smiles. It expressed his praise to God in the midst of pain as well as pleasure -- in difficulties as well as delights. The pain and difficulties of his life did more to build strength and gratefulness in his heart than did any of his human pleasure.

In 2 weeks we will start Rev. 18. Now that religious Babylon has been destroyed, we will turn to the destruction of political and economic Babylon.



August L. Storm
(1862–1914)

Eight years after writing this hymn, at age 37, August Storm faced a crippling back problem. But God used his disability to prove His sufficiency -- and to give additional depth to the young man's teaching and writing. Storm's high calling to continual suffering made his life all the more a testimony to God's sufficiency. He knew the source of endurance and gave God the glory. This hymn was written in Swedish. It was translated into English in 1931, by Carl Ernest Backstrom (1901-1984). The original version had four stanzas, but when he made his translation Backstrom reduced the number to three, incorporating some of the ideas from the other stanzas into his adaptation. In Storm's Swedish version, he lists some thirty-two things to be thankful for.

August L. Storm
(1862–1914)

A year before his death on July 1, 1914, he wrote another poem in which he thanked God for the years of calm and quiet as well as the years of pain. After his funeral, the Swedish *War Cry* wrote the following:

“It was a delight to listen to his powerful, thoughtful, and well-articulated sermons. And the numerous verses that flowed from his pen are the best that have ever appeared in the Army's publications.”
