



- Babylon will not only be the religious headquarters of the world system but also the commercial headquarters.
- What will one day be a great religious and commercial center will become a house of demons and a prison house for every unclean spirit and bird and every hated beast. This is a picture of complete desolation.
- This is the judgment of international government, multinational organizations and financial institutions.

Which demons are we talking about?

- 1. Chapter 9 200,000,000 released out of the abyss along with the 4 that were bound at the Euphrates River.
- 2. Chapter 12 All of the demons which had access to heaven, are cast out of heaven down to earth.
- 3. Chapter 16:13,14 3 frog-demons going out to deceive the whole world to draw the nations to Armageddon.

**All demons have been released. And the headquarters for the whole demon operation is none other than the city of Babylon. This is the reason for the judgment – the city is the most vile, demon filled, demon possessed place on earth. And it is the capitol of the Antichrist. "She has become a dwelling place of demons and a prison of every unclean spirit, and a prison of every unclean and hateful bird."

"has become" is εγενετο aorist tense. The angel describes her condition after her fall.

"Dwelling place" is κατοικητηριον[katoikētērion] - a place where residents settle down with the idea of a long stay. This is home for these demons.

"unclean" is ακαθαρτου [akathartou], meaning filthy.

"prison" is φυλακη - A place that is guarded, a prison. The fallen city of Babylon becomes a prison for all kinds of unclean spirits and birds. Birds are often used in Scripture as agents of Satan.

- Instead of drunk on religion, here the nations are drunk on greed, money and materialism.
- They are drunk on the passion for riches and wealth.
- It will be worldwide all nations will lust for what Babylon is promoting. She will seduce the whole world.
- The source and wealth center of it all will be Babylon.

- We can understand some of what this is like as we move closer to a one-world global economy. The world is all tied together. No nation's economy exists in isolation. What happens here affects everyone else in the world and what happens in the world affects us here – stock markets, the dollar, the euro, the yen, the pound, the franc, the rand, gold, silver, leadership changes, depressions, collapses, etc.
- If you are driven by wealth and greed you must move to global markets. Your drive for money and materialism will force eventually a one-world global economy which will one day play into the hands of the Antichrist.

- "and the kings of the earth have committed acts of immorality with her, and the merchants of the earth have become rich by the wealth of her sensuality."
- "kings" political leaders in government, leaders of nations, presidents, prime ministers, chancellors, kings, queens and rulers.
- "merchants" businessmen, power brokers, traders, CEOs, bankers, marketers, financiers, magnates, moguls, etc.
- Political leaders use merchants who use religious leaders who use political leaders who use religious leaders who use merchants. This always has been, always will be until God destroys it all.
- Alliances will be made at every level between religious leaders and businessmen, political leaders and power brokers, prime ministers and religious leaders. Deals will be cut and there will be tremendous riches to be had. Kings and presidents will get rich. The Harlot will get rich. Merchants will get rich. It will be a frenzy of buying and selling driven by Babylon. Its Christmas commercialism on steroids. Greed and materialism will hit its peak. Selfishness will rule. People will be deceived and taken advantage of in this system of "economic prostitution."
- And in the Tribulation the entire world's economy will be controlled by the Antichrist through his mark "666", which is required to buy and sell anything and everything.

"It has become an axiom that "corporations have no souls," and upon this all great moneyed corporations act, though the men who constitute them will find out a different doctrine when they come to the day of judgment. And when it comes to these great and ever magnifying commercial compacts and interests, there is not a law of God or man which is not compelled to yield if found in the way. . . . If the question were ever pressed in these circles, What is truth? it would be hooted and laughed to scorn. The cry would be, "What have we to do with that? Let every one quietly enjoy his own opinions." . . . Church is nothing, State is nothing, creed is nothing, Bible is nothing, Sunday is nothing, religious scruples are nothing, conscience is nothing, everything is practically nothing, except as it can be turned or used to the one great end of accumulation and wealth."

- We are not talking about evangelism anymore. These hearts are hardened with the mark of the Beast.
- This has always been God's will Get out before judgment falls.

The voice from heaven gives two reasons believers should separate themselves from the Babylonian system:

- 1) "so that you will not participate in her sins"
- 2) "and receive of her plagues."
- The same standard applies to us today. Separate (do not participate)in the things of the world or face the consequences.

1 John 2:15-17

15 Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world.

17 The world is passing away, and also its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.

"her sins have piled up as high as heaven"

"piled up" - $K\alpha\lambda\lambda\alpha\omega$ – glued, welded, stuck, or fastened together.

This is an obvious reference to the tower of Babel and a play on the words in Gen. 11:4.

Gen 11:4

4 They said, "Come, let us build for ourselves a city, and a tower whose top will reach into heaven,

Note:

- Sins, like bricks, are laid down one after another, and the end result brings the far reaching consequences of judgment.
- They first built a tower to reach heaven and it failed.
 However a new tower has reached heaven –
 the tower of sin.

Next week we will see the judgment that falls on the city of Babylon and the reaction of the political leaders and merchants who were dependent on her for their great power and wealth.



Charles Wesley (1707–1788)

Many of the carols we sing have a rich theological tradition, and this hymn we are looking at tonight is no exception. It was written by Charles Wesley, who was an English Methodist leader and hymn writer. Wesley wrote over 6,000 hymns, more than any other male writer (Fanny Crosby wrote 8,000). His hymns include "O for a Thousand Tongues to Sing," "Jesus, Lover of My Soul," "Christ the Lord Is Risen Today," and "Love Divine, All Loves Excelling."

His goal in writing hymns was to teach the poor and illiterate sound doctrine. His brother, John Wesley, a famous theologian and founder of Methodism, said that Charles' hymnal was the best theological book in existence. Some have noted that Methodism was born in song and Charles was the chief songwriter.

Wesley, inspired by the sounds of London church bells while walking to church on Christmas Day, wrote this poem about a year after his conversion to be read on Christmas Day. The poem first appeared in Hymns and Sacred Poems in 1739.



Charles Wesley (1707–1788)

This hymn was originally sung to the tune of *Amazing Grace*, and later to the tune of *Christ the Lord is Risen Today*. In 1840, famed classical composer Felix Mendelssohn composed a cantata to commemorate the invention of the printing press by Johann Gutenberg. William H. Cummings adapted music from Mendelssohn's cantata to fit the lyrics to this hymn. George Whitfield (1714-1770), a preacher in the Church of England and later a Methodist minister, gave us the familiar melody sung today.

This is one of the few Christmas hymns written in the 17thand early 18th Centuries, after the English Puritan's abolished Christmas Carols for being part of a "worldly festival".

This carol is sung in the uplifting James Stewart movie "It's a Wonderful Life".

The name of this Christmas Carol and hymn is . . .

HARK! THE HERALD ANGELS SING

1. Hark! The herald angels sing,
Glory to the newborn King;
Peace on earth, and mercy mild,
God and sinners reconciled!
Joyful, all ye nations rise,
Join the triumph of the skies;
With th'angelic host proclaim,
Christ is born in Bethlehem!
