

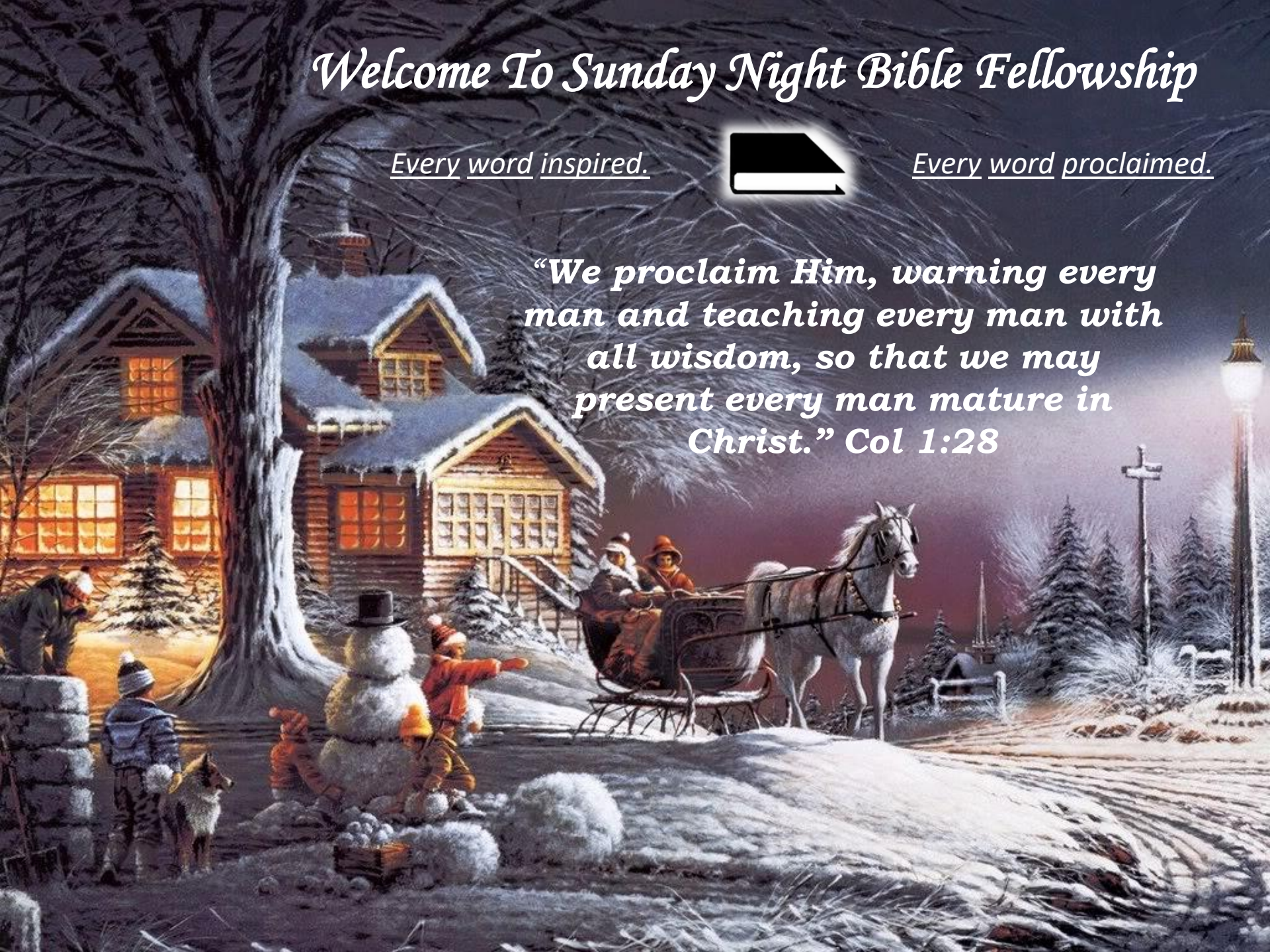

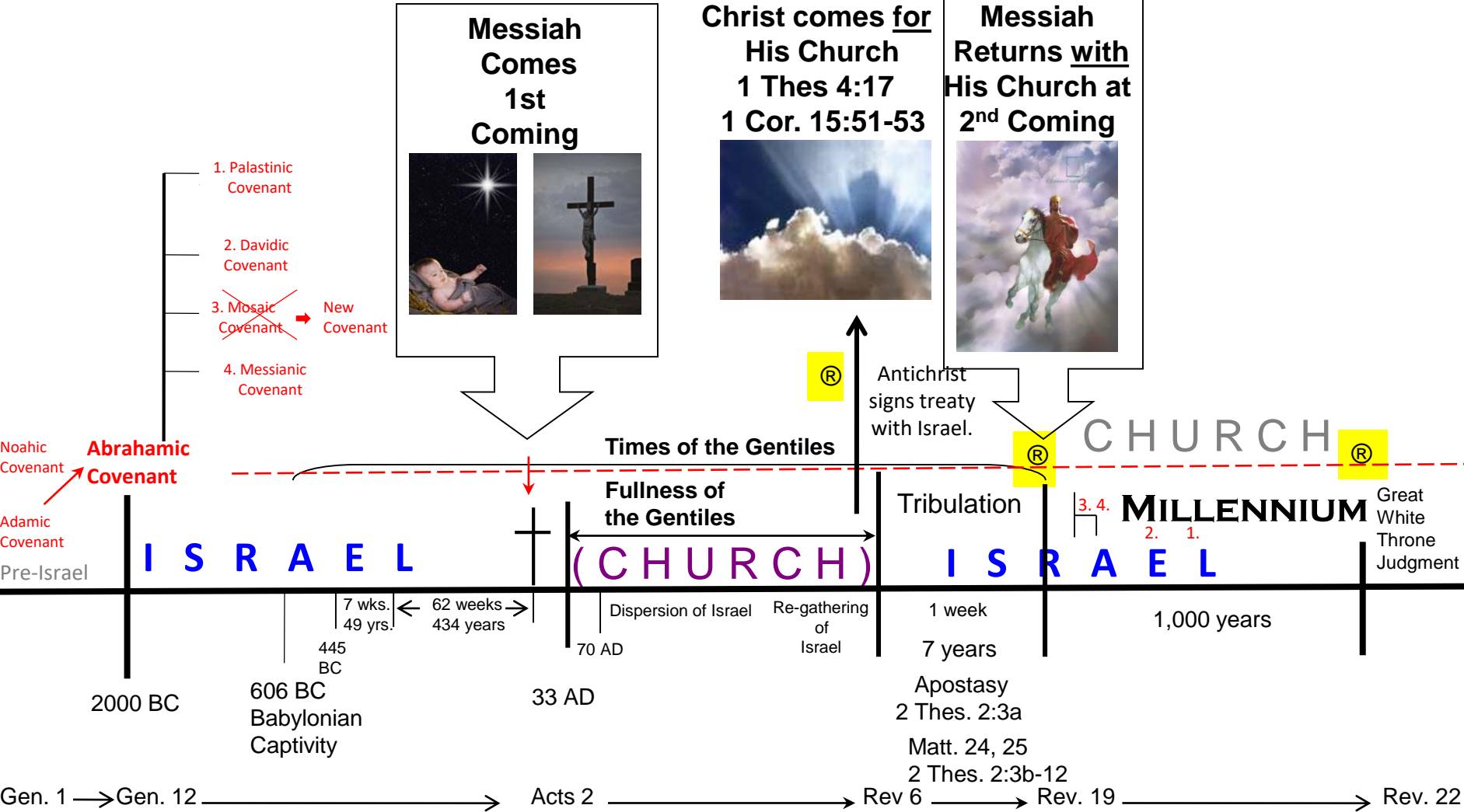

# *The Ministry of Angels*

- 1. Worship and praise to God**—This is their main activity in Heaven (Isaiah 6:1-3; Revelation 4-5).
- 2. Messengers**—They serve as messengers to communicate God's will to men. Examples -
  - they helped reveal the law to Moses (Acts 7:52-53).
  - They gave instructions to Joseph about the birth of Jesus (Matthew 1-2), to the women at the tomb, to Philip (Acts 8:26), and to Cornelis (Acts 10:1-8).
  - They communicate to John in Revelation.
- 3. Providers**—God used angels to provide physical needs such as food for Hagar (Genesis 21:17-20), Elijah (1 Kings 19:6), and Christ after His temptation (Matthew 4:11).
- 4. Protectors**—Keeping God's people out of physical danger, as in the cases of Daniel and the lions, and his three friends in the fiery furnace (Daniel 3 and 6).
- 5. Deliverers**—they delivered God's people out of danger. They released the apostles from prison in Acts 5, and Peter in Acts 12.

- 6. Gave strength and encouragement**—Angels strengthened Jesus after His temptation (Matt 4:11), encouraged the apostles to keep preaching after releasing them from prison (Acts 5:19-20), and told Paul that everyone on his ship would survive the impending shipwreck (Acts 27:23-25).
- 7. Answer prayer**—God often uses angels as His means of answering the prayers of His people (Daniel 9:20-24—Gabriel sent to Daniel; 10:10-12—Michael sent to Daniel; Acts 12:1-17—Peter released from prison).
- 8. Caring for believers at the moment of death**—In the story of Lazarus and the rich man, we read that angels carried the spirit of Lazarus to “Abraham’s bosom” when he died (Luke 16:22).
- 9. Executioners**—Angels are sometimes used by God to punish sin. An angel of the Lord went forth and destroyed an Assyrian camp (2 Kings 19:20-34). At the time of Moses and the Exodus, the Egyptian firstborn were killed by angels.
- 10. Ministers to the believers**—“Are they [angels] not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?” —Hebrews 1:14 . The verb “minister” means to attend to the needs of someone.

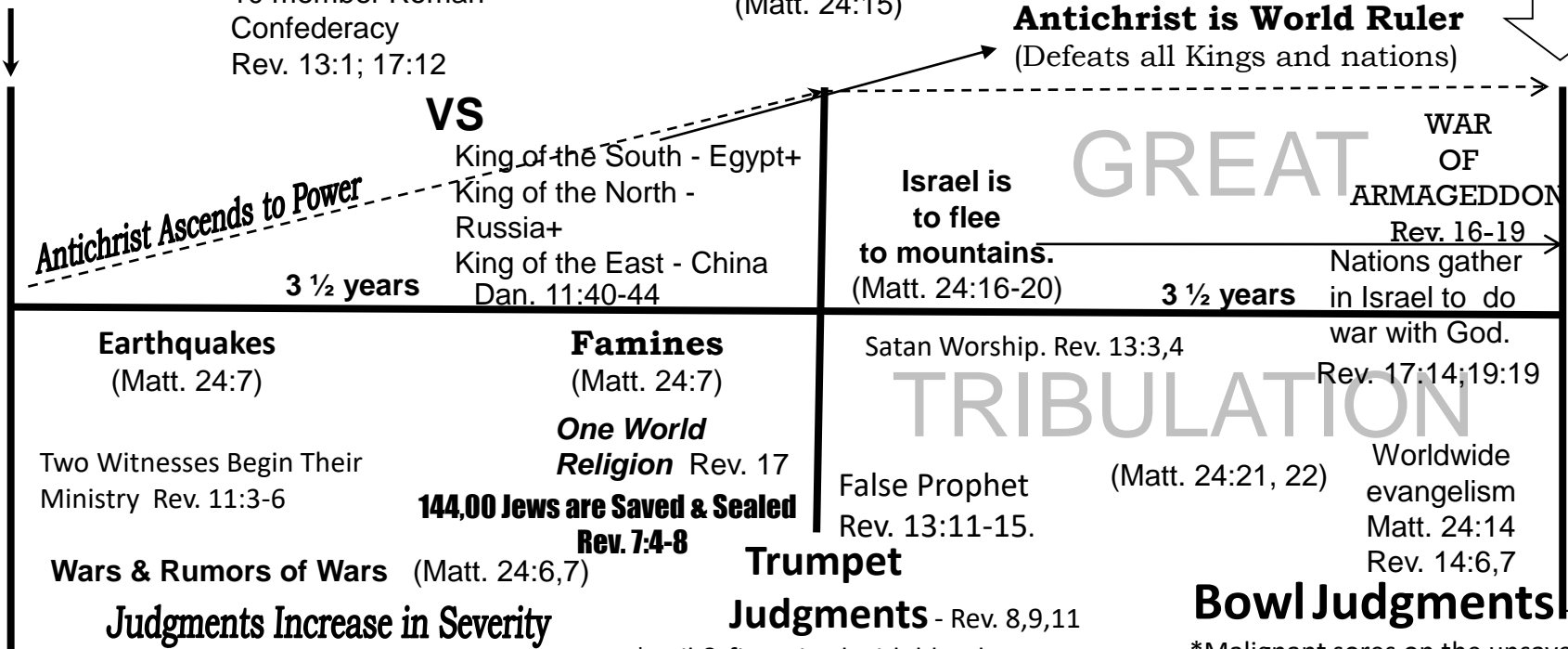

## **Rev 19:7-10**

9 Then he said to me, "Write, 'Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.'" And he said to me, "These are true words of God."

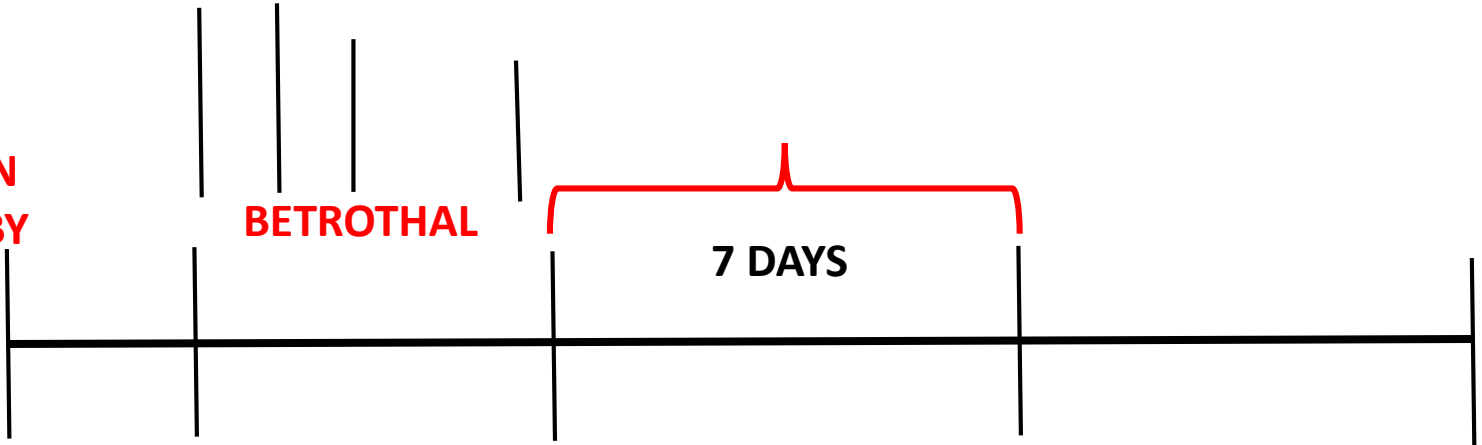

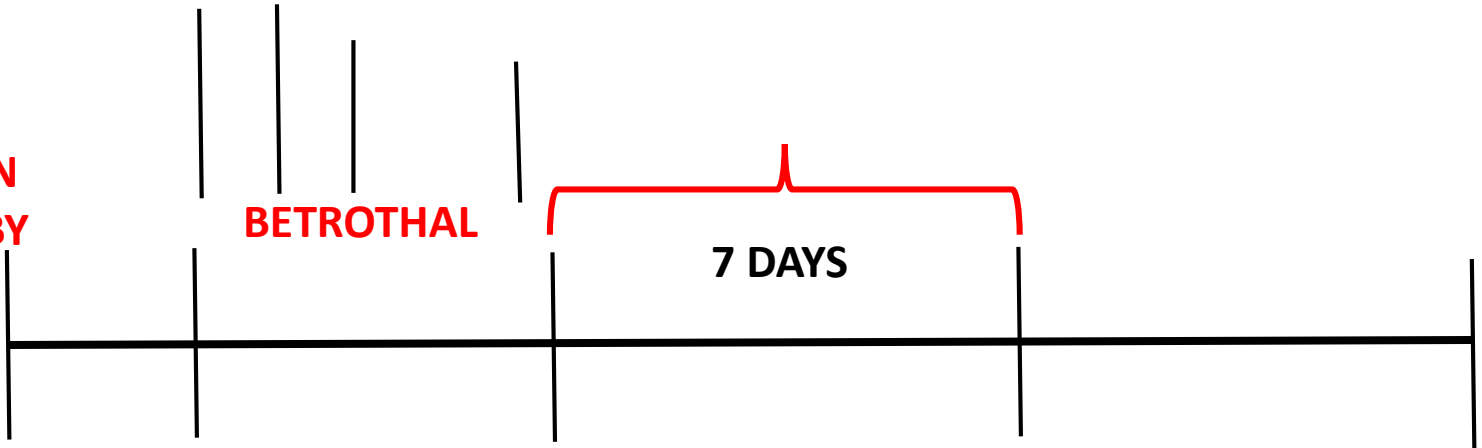
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## **Gen 34:11-12**

11 Shechem also said to her father and to her brothers, "If I find favor in your sight, then I will give whatever you say to me.

12 "Ask me ever so much bridal payment and gift, and I will give according as you say to me; but give me the girl in marriage."



- The Ketubbah is mainly about the bridegroom and what he is going to provide for the bride.
- The "Bride Price" was a sum of money or material items defined in the Ketubbah that the groom had to pay the father of the bride and done for these reasons:
  1. To compensate the bride's family.
  2. In the event he divorced her for no cause.
  3. In the event he was guilty of adultery.
  4. In the event he takes on a second wife.

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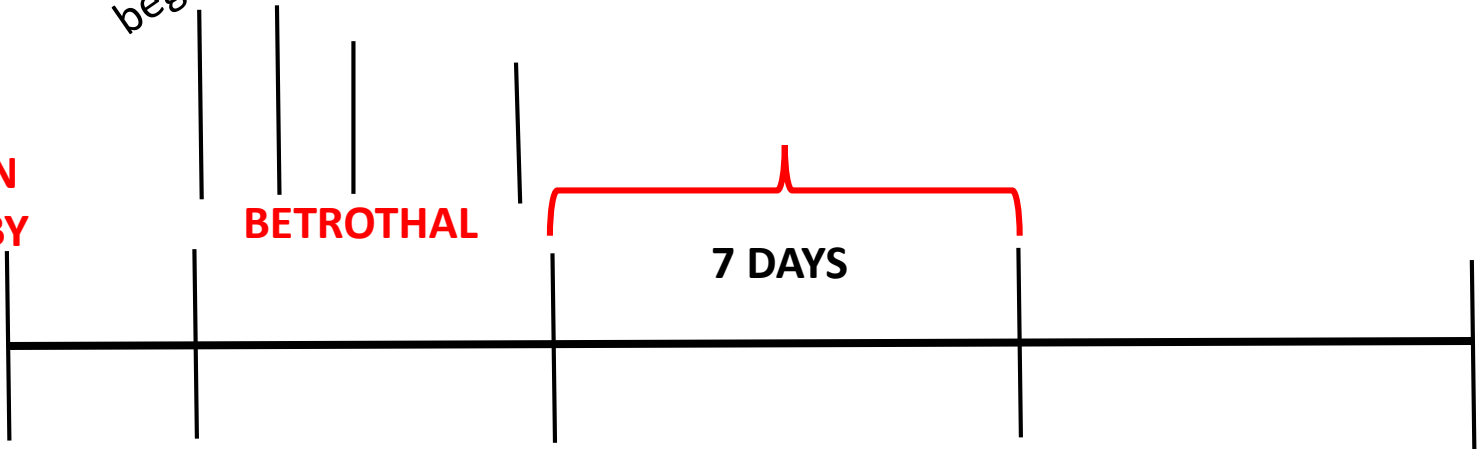
# Jewish Marriage Customs

1. Selection of couple by parents.
2. Price (Dowry) paid by bridegroom to obtain the bride. This is a binding contract. Ketubbah.
3. The couple meets one another and the betrothal period begins (1-2 years). Both immerse in a ritual cleansing.

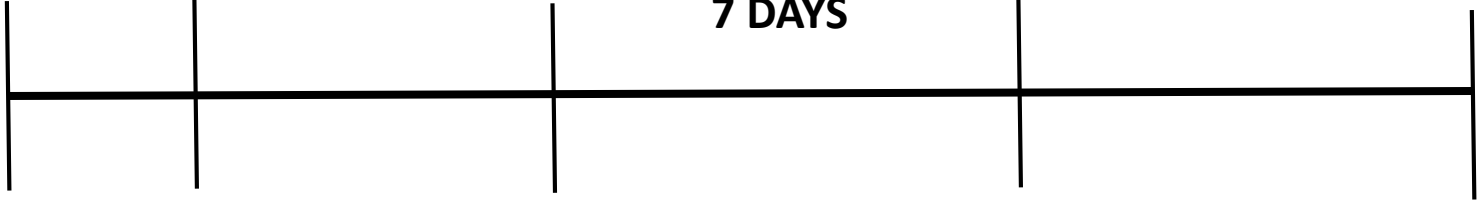
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5. Bridegroom announces he is going to prepare a place for the couple. Bridegroom leaves a gift (pledge).

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**Huppa is symbolic of the place the Bridegroom has prepared for his Bride.**



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6. Father of the bridegroom determines wedding day when he is satisfied everything is ready. Tells bridegroom to get his bride.
7. Bridegroom and friends come for his bride.

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
