



Rev 20:1-6


- 4 Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.
- 5 The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were completed. This is the first resurrection.
- 6 Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.
- 7 When the thousand years are completed, Satan will be released from his prison,
- 8 and will come out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together for the war; the number of them is like the sand of the seashore.
- 9 And they came up on the broad plain of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city, and fire came down from heaven and devoured them.
- 10 And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.




- 10 As to this salvation, the prophets who prophesied of the grace that would come to you made careful searches and inquiries,

- **Millennium** is a period equal to 1000 years. It derives from the Latin *mille*, thousand, and *annus*, year. Not found in the Bible (like Trinity).
- "Kingdom" God's reign, his lordship, his sovereign governance. The Kingdom of God is the realm where God reigns supreme, and Jesus Christ is King. Not heaven or the church. The kingdom of God is not an actual physical place.

- 1 The earth is the Lord's, and all it contains,
- The world, and those who dwell in it.

Ps 103:19

- 9 The Lord has established His throne in the heavens,
- And His sovereignty rules over all.





- 12 Characteristics of the Millennium:
- 1. God's Covenants with Israel are fulfilled.
- Palestinic Covenant land boundaries are established.
 (Gen. 15:18-21; Ez. 47:13-21; 48:8,23,27)
- Davidic Covenant is fulfilled with Christ on the throne of David. (2 Sa 7:11-16; Is 9:6,7 Jer. 33:17-26; Amos 9:11,12, Lk 1:32, 33) This covenant promised four eternal things: an eternal dynasty, an eternal kingdom, an eternal throne, and an eternal person.
- New Covenant is fulfilled all of Israel is saved. (Jer. 31:31, Rom. 11:26)
- Abrahamic and Messianic covenants are fulfilled as the world blessed through Israel - (Mic 5:7)



Deut 30:1-10

- 1 "So it shall be when all of these things have come upon you, the blessing and the curse which I have set before you, and you call them to mind in all nations where the Lord your God has banished you,
- 2 and you return to the Lord your God and obey Him with all your heart and soul according to all that I command you today, you and your sons,
- 3 then the Lord your **God will restore you from captivity**, and have compassion on you, and **will gather you again** from all the peoples where the Lord your God has scattered you.
- 4 "If your outcasts are at the ends of the earth, from there the Lord your God will gather you, and from there He will bring you back.
- 5 "The Lord your God will bring you into the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it; and He will prosper you and multiply you more than your fathers.
- 6 "Moreover the Lord your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your descendants, to love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, so that you may live.
- 7 "The Lord your God will inflict all these curses on your enemies and on those who hate you, who persecuted you.
- 8 "And you shall again obey the Lord, and observe all His commandments which I command you today.
- 9 "Then the Lord your God will prosper you abundantly in all the work of your hand, in the offspring of your body and in the offspring of your cattle and in the produce of your ground, for the Lord will again rejoice over you for good, just as He rejoiced over your fathers;
- 10 if you obey the Lord your God to keep His commandments and His statutes which are written in this book of the law, if you turn to the Lord your God with all your heart and soul.

Matt 24:30-31



Stage One: The Marriage Contract

Deut 7:6-10

- 6 "For you are a holy people to the Lord your God; the Lord your God has chosen you to be a people for His own possession out of all the peoples who are on the face of the earth.
- 7 "The Lord did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any of the peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples,
- 8 but because the Lord loved you and kept the oath which He swore to your forefathers, the Lord brought you out by a mighty hand and redeemed you from the house of slavery, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.
- 9 "Know therefore that the Lord your God, He is God, the faithful God, who keeps His covenant and His lovingkindness to a thousandth generation with those who love Him and keep His commandments;

Ezek 16:8-14

covered you with silk.

- 8 "Then I passed by you and saw you, and behold, you were at the time for love; so I spread My skirt over you and covered your nakedness. I also swore to you and entered into a covenant with you so that you became Mine," declares the Lord God.

 9 "Then I bathed you with water, washed off your blood from you
- and anointed you with oil.

 10 "I also clothed you with embroidered cloth and put sandals of porpoise skin on your feet; and I wrapped you with fine linen and
- 11 "I adorned you with ornaments, put bracelets on your hands and a necklace around your neck.12 "I also put a ring in your nostril, earrings in your ears and a
- beautiful crown on your head.

 13 "Thus you were adorned with gold and silver, and your dress was of fine linen, silk and embroidered cloth. You ate fine flour, honey and oil; so you were exceedingly beautiful and advanced to royalty.
- 14 "Then your fame went forth among the nations on account of your beauty, for it was perfect because of My splendor which I bestowed on you," declares the Lord God.

Stage Two: Israel's Adultery (Psalms 28:9; 33:12; 78:62, 71; 94:14; and 106:40, Hos 2:2-5)

Jer 3:1-3

- 3 God says, "If a husband divorces his wife And she goes from him And belongs to another man, Will he still return to her? Will not that land be completely polluted? But you are a harlot with many lovers; Yet you turn to Me," declares the Lord.
- 2 "Lift up your eyes to the bare heights and see; Where have you not been violated? By the roads you have sat for them like an Arab in the desert, And you have polluted a land with your harlotry and with your wickedness.
- 3 "Therefore the showers have been withheld, And there has been no spring rain. Yet you had a harlot's forehead; You refused to be ashamed.

Ezek 16:15-34

- 15 "But you trusted in your beauty and played the harlot because of your fame, and you poured out your harlotries on every passer-by who might be willing.
- 16 "You took some of your clothes, made for yourself high places of various colors and played the harlot on them, which should never come about nor happen.
- 17 "You also took your beautiful jewels made of My gold and of My silver, which I had given you, and made for yourself male images that you might play the harlot with them.

Stage Three: The Separation

Isa 50:1

- 50 Thus says the Lord,
- "Where is the certificate of divorce
- By which I have sent your mother away?
- Or to whom of My creditors did I sell you?
- Behold, you were sold for your iniquities,
- And for your transgressions your mother was sent away.
- *Lasted for approx. 100 years.

Stage Four: The Divorce

Jer 3:6-10

- 6 Then the Lord said to me in the days of Josiah the king, "Have you seen what faithless Israel did? She went up on every high hill and under every green tree, and she was a harlot there.
- 7 "I thought, 'After she has done all these things she will return to Me'; but she did not return, and her treacherous sister Judah saw it.
- 8 "And I saw that for all the adulteries of faithless Israel, I had sent her away and given her a writ of divorce, yet her treacherous sister Judah did not fear; but she went and was a harlot also.
- 9 "Because of the lightness of her harlotry, she polluted the land and committed adultery with stones and trees.
- 10 "Yet in spite of all this her treacherous sister Judah did not return to Me with all her heart, but rather in deception," declares the Lord.

Stage Five: The Punishment

Ezek 16:35-43

- 35 Therefore, O harlot, hear the word of the Lord.
- 36 Thus says the Lord God, "Because your lewdness was poured out and your nakedness uncovered through your harlotries with your lovers and with all your detestable idols, and because of the blood of your sons which you gave to idols,
- 37 therefore, behold, I will gather all your lovers with whom you took pleasure, even all those whom you loved and all those whom you hated. So I will gather them against you from every direction and expose your nakedness to them that they may see all your nakedness.
- 38 "Thus I will judge you like women who commit adultery or shed blood are judged; and I will bring on you the blood of wrath and jealousy.
- 39 "I will also give you into the hands of your lovers, and they will tear down your shrines, demolish your high places, strip you of your clothing, take away your jewels, and will leave you naked and bare.
- 40 "They will incite a crowd against you and they will stone you and cut you to pieces with their swords.
- 41 "They will burn your houses with fire and execute judgments on you in the sight of many women. Then I will stop you from playing the harlot, and you will also no longer pay your lovers.
- 42 "So I will calm My fury against you and My jealousy will depart from you, and I will be pacified and angry no more.
- 43 "Because you have not remembered the days of your youth but have enraged Me by all these things, behold, I in turn will bring your conduct down on your own head," declares the Lord God, "so that you will not commit this lewdness on top of all your other abominations.

*Israel is still at this stage today.

Stage Six: Remarriage

Jer 31:31-34

- 31 "Behold, days are coming," declares the Lord, "when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah,
- 32 not like the covenant which I made with their fathers in the day I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was a husband to them," declares the Lord.
- 33 "But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days," declares the Lord, "I will put My law within them and on their heart I will write it; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.
- 34 "They will not teach again, each man his neighbor and each man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them," declares the Lord, "for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."

- *Nations will worship in Jerusalem.
- *Jerusalem is made the world's capital.

The Millennial River - Ezekiel 47:1–12, Joel 3:18, Zechariah 14:8, Ezekiel 47:8–10.

Ezek 47:1-2

- 1 Then he brought me back to the door of the house; and behold, water was flowing from under the threshold of the house toward the east, for the house faced east. And the water was flowing down from under, from the right side of the house, from south of the altar.
- 2 He brought me out by way of the north gate and led me around on the outside to the outer gate by way of the gate that faces east. And behold, water was trickling from the south side.

Joel 3:18

8 And in that day

The mountains will drip with sweet wine,

And the hills will flow with milk,

And all the brooks of Judah will flow with water;

And a spring will go out from the house of the Lord

To water the valley of Shittim.

Zech 14:4,8





7. Radical Changes in Nature.

The effects of the curse will be mostly gone. All of creation will experience the dramatic change.

Rom 8:19-22

- 20 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it, in hope
- 21 that the creation itself also will be set free from its slavery to corruption into the freedom of the glory of the children of God.

- 3 Let the mountains bring peace to the people,
- And the hills, in righteousness.
- 4 May he vindicate the afflicted of the people,
- Save the children of the needy
- And crush the oppressor.
- 5 Let them fear You while the sun endures,
- And as long as the moon, throughout all generations.
- 6 May he come down like rain upon the mown grass,
- Like showers that water the earth.
- 7 In his days may the righteous flourish,
- And abundance of peace till the moon is no more.
- 8 May he also rule from sea to sea
- And from the River to the ends of the earth.
- 9 Let the nomads of the desert bow before him,
- And his enemies lick the dust.

11. God's presence will be fully recognized and fellowship with God will be experienced to an unprecedented degree (Ezek. 37:27-28; Zech. 2:2, 10-13; Rev. 21:3).

12. O.T. Sacrifices will be resumed as a memorial and teaching tool.

While the sacrifices that Israel brought, once had a prospective meaning, the sacrifices brought in the millennial Temple have a retrospective meaning."

Ezek 40:39

39 In the porch of the gate were two tables on each side, on which to slaughter the burnt offering, the sin offering and the guilt offering.

Ezek 43:18

18 And He said to me, "Son of man, thus says the Lord God, 'These are the statutes for the altar on the day it is built, to offer burnt offerings on it and to sprinkle blood on it.

Heb 7:19

19 (for the Law made nothing perfect), and on the other hand there is a bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God.

9 which is a symbol for the present time. Accordingly both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make the worshiper perfect in conscience,

4 For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.



Features Unique to the Millennial (Ezekiel's) Temple

No wall of partition to exclude Gentiles (compare Ephesians 2:14) The Gentiles were previously welcome in the Outer Courts, but excluded from the inner courts on pain of death.

No Court of Women (compare Galatians 3:28. Outer Court and Inner Court only)

No Laver (Ezekiel 36:24-27, John 15:3)

No Table of Shewbread (Micah 5:4, John 6:35)

No Lampstand or Menorah (see Isaiah 49:6, John 8:12)

No Golden Altar of Incense (Zechariah 8:20-23, John 14:6)

No Veil (Isaiah 25:6-8, Matthew 27:51)

No Ark of the Covenant (Jeremiah 3:16, John 10:30-33)

Major Changes to the Sacrificial Altar:

- Altar will be in the inner court and not outer court.
- The Altar will be approached by a ramp from the East. Previous altars were all approached from the South.
- Now there will be stairs to the altar, not a ramp as previously.
