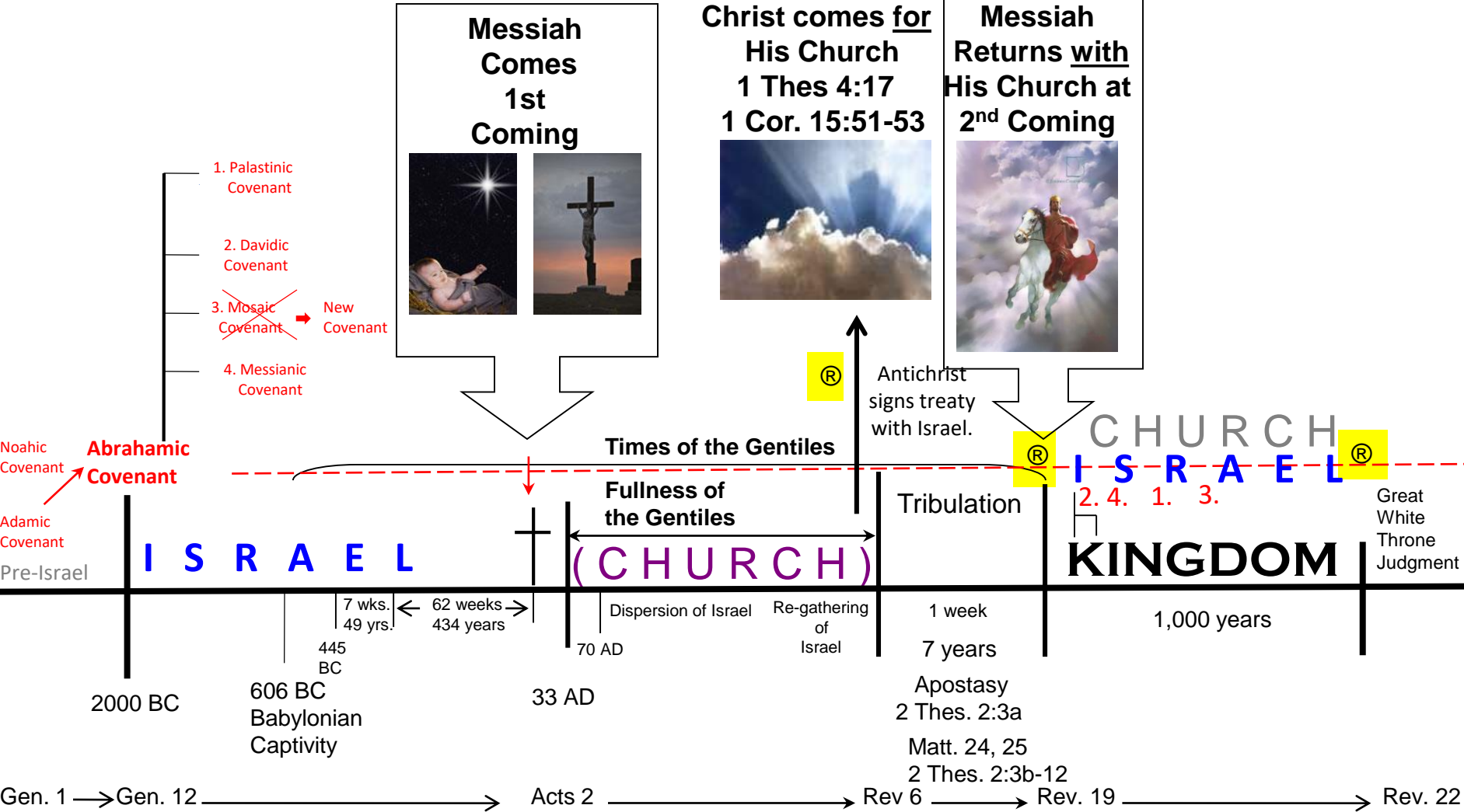

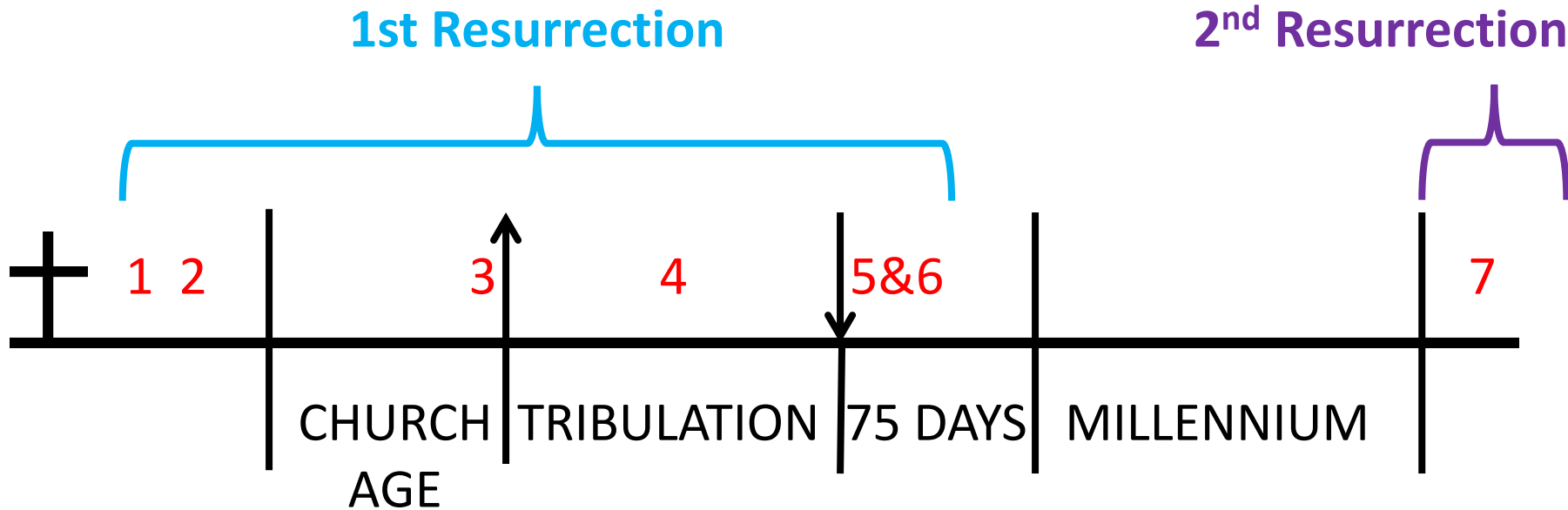

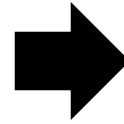

3. Place where Satan is bound during the Millennium (Rev. 20:1-3)

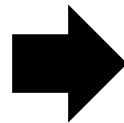


LAKE OF FIRE

1. Final destination for all eternity of all the unsaved (Rev 20:15).
2. Final destination for all eternity for Satan, the Beast, and False Prophet (Rev. 20:10).
3. Final destination for all eternity for death and Hades (Rev. 20:14).

PLACE OF TORMENT

Place where all unbelievers go and await final judgment (Luke 16:22-31).



Satan is not now bound during the Church Age -

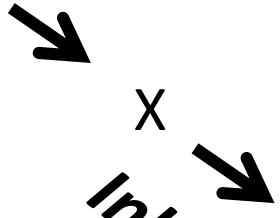
- Satan filled the heart of Ananias to lie to the Holy Spirit resulting in the death of he and his wife (Acts 5:3).
- Paul said that Satan is blinding the eyes of nonbelievers in this current age so that they should not receive the gospel (2 Cor. 4:3-4).
- Paul told the Corinthians that Satan transforms himself (deceptively) into an angel of light (2 Cor. 11:14).
- Paul was given a thorn in the flesh, “a messenger of Satan” to keep him humble (2 Cor. 12:7).
- Paul told the Ephesians that the prince of the power of the air “now works in the sons of disobedience” (Eph. 2:2).
- Paul told the Ephesians not to give place to the devil (Eph. 4:27) and that they wrestled against “spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*” (Eph. 6:12).

- Paul was hindered by Satan from visiting the Thessalonian church (1Th. 2:18).
- The coming of the lawless one, the Antichrist, will be “according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs and lying wonders” (2Th. 2:9). This is fulfilled, in part, by the activities of the False Prophet documented in the book of Revelation.
- Paul delivered Hymenaeus and Alexander to Satan so that they might learn not to blaspheme (1Ti. 1:20).
- James warns believers to submit to God and resist the devil (Jas. 4:7).
- Peter warns believers to be sober and vigilant because “your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour” (1Pe. 5:8).
- John tells us that “the whole world lies *under the sway* of the wicked one” (1Jn. 5:19).
- Satan is a source of deception throughout the events of the book of Revelation (Rev. 12:9; 13:14; 18:23; 19:20; 20:8, 10).

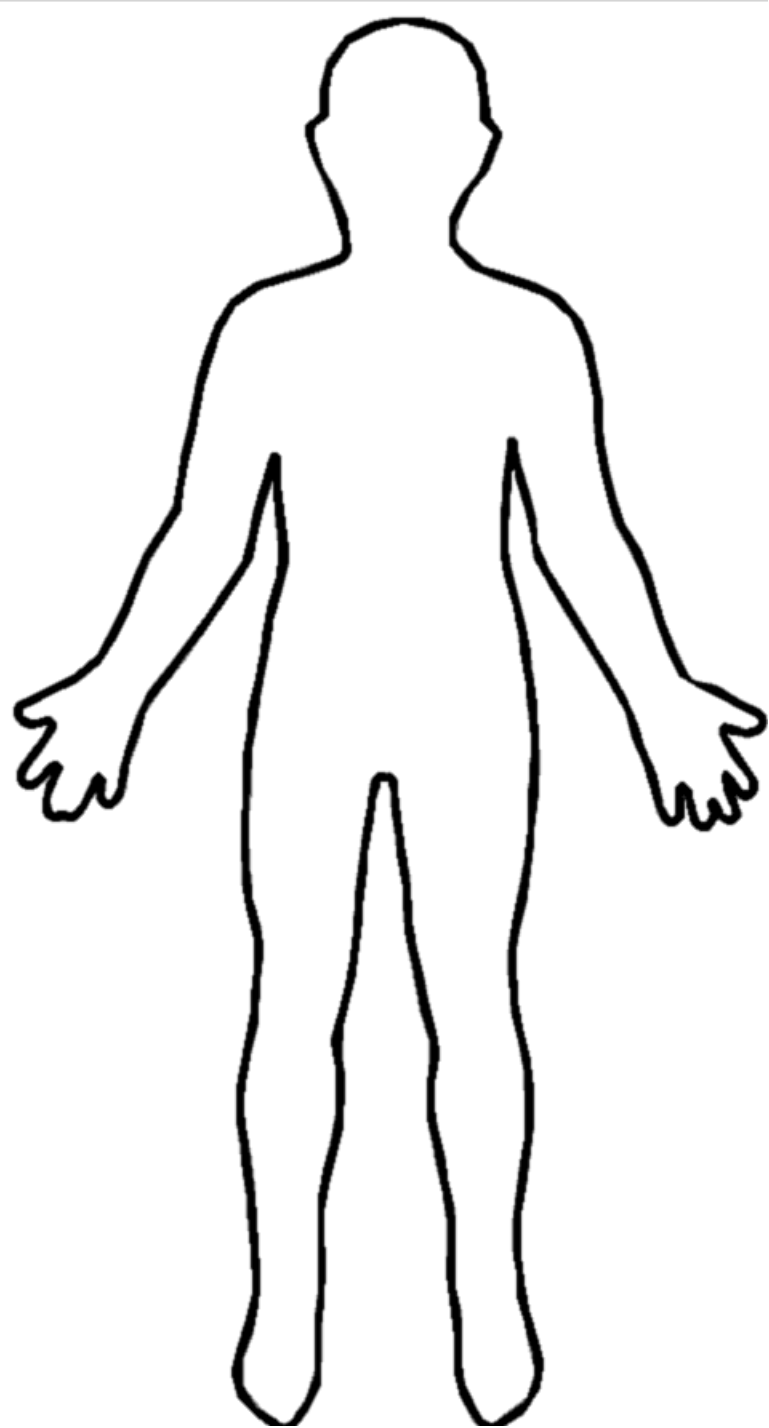

Does incarceration change anyone?

- Prison never rehabilitates anyone.

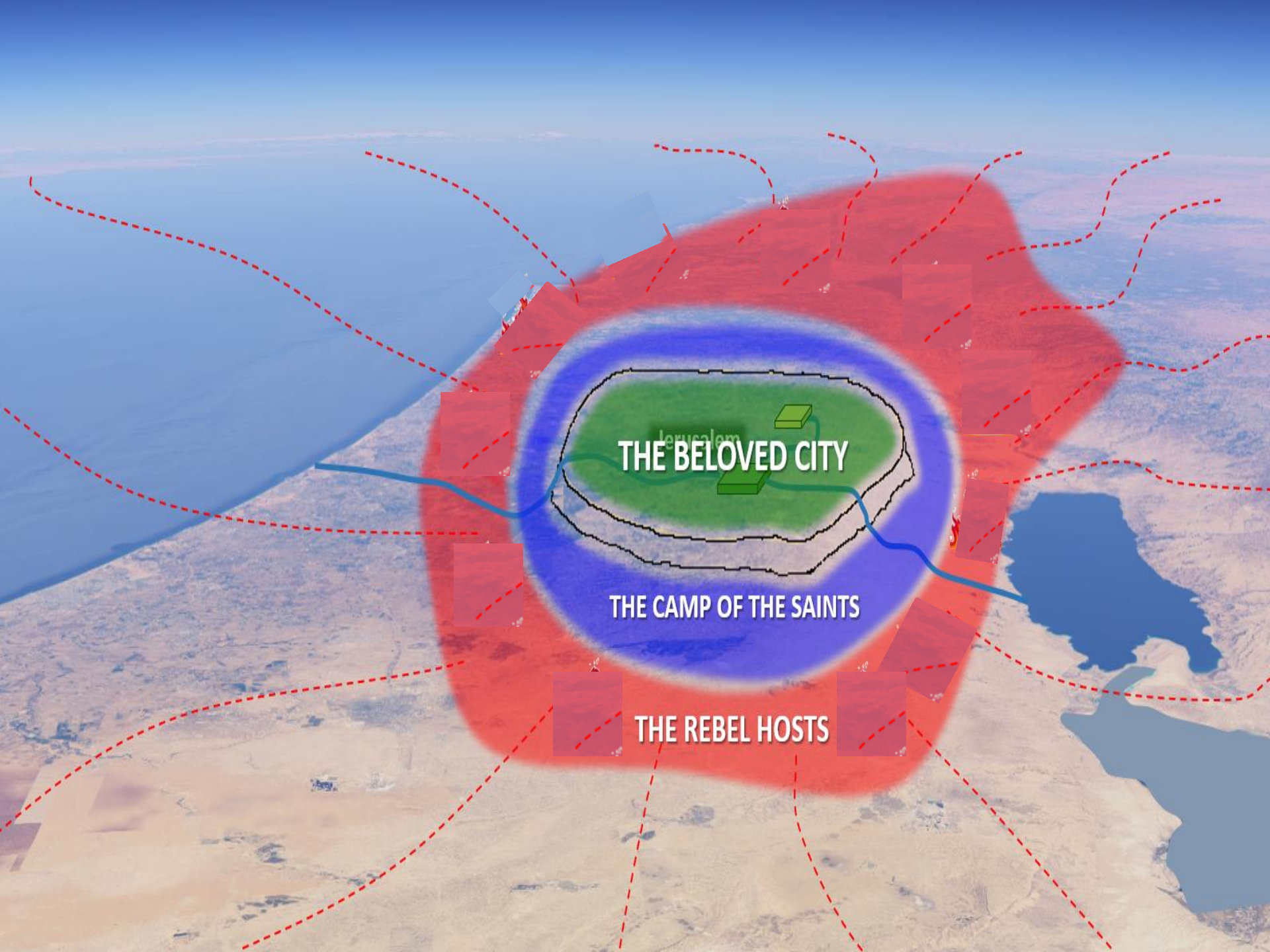

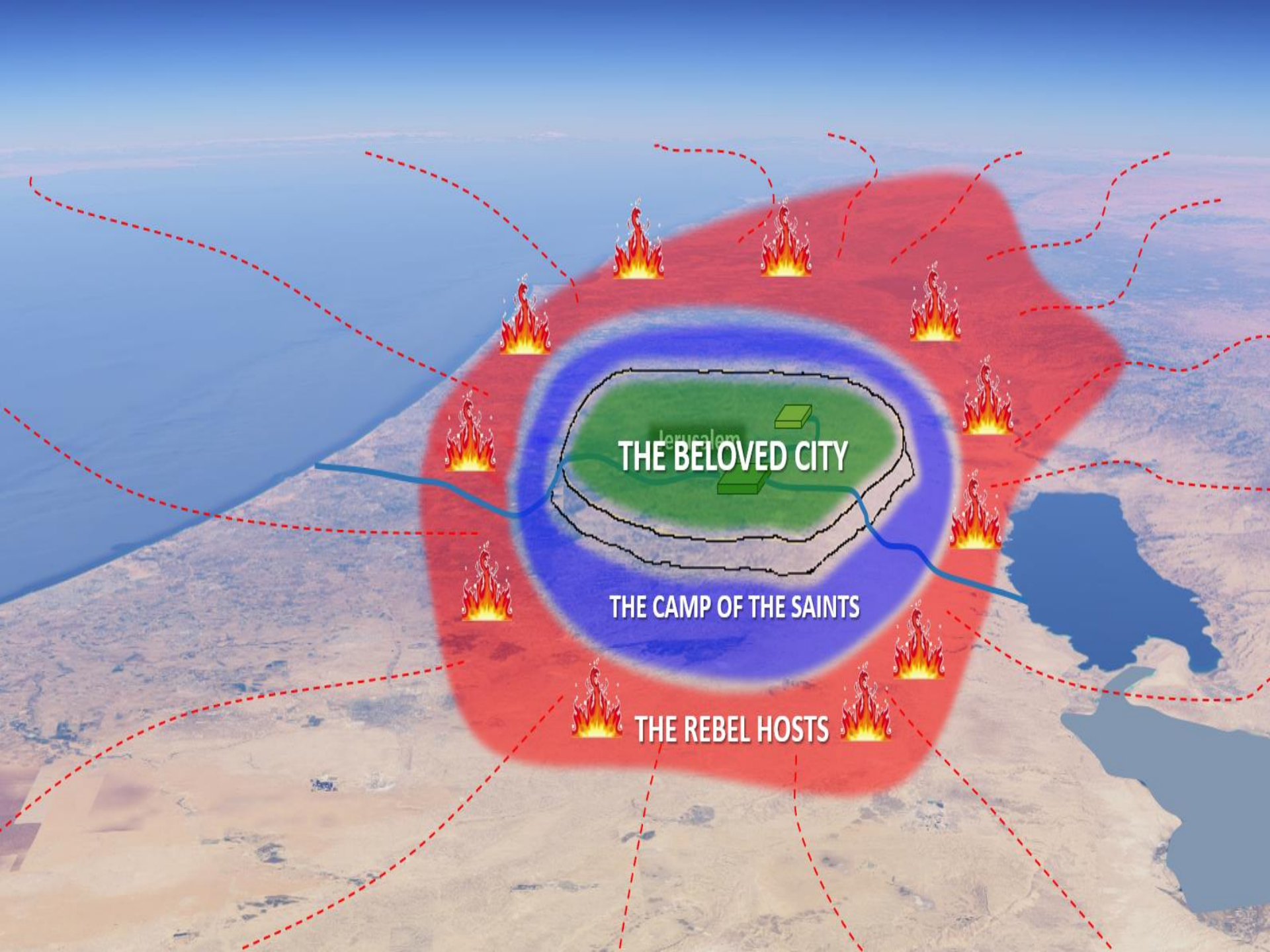

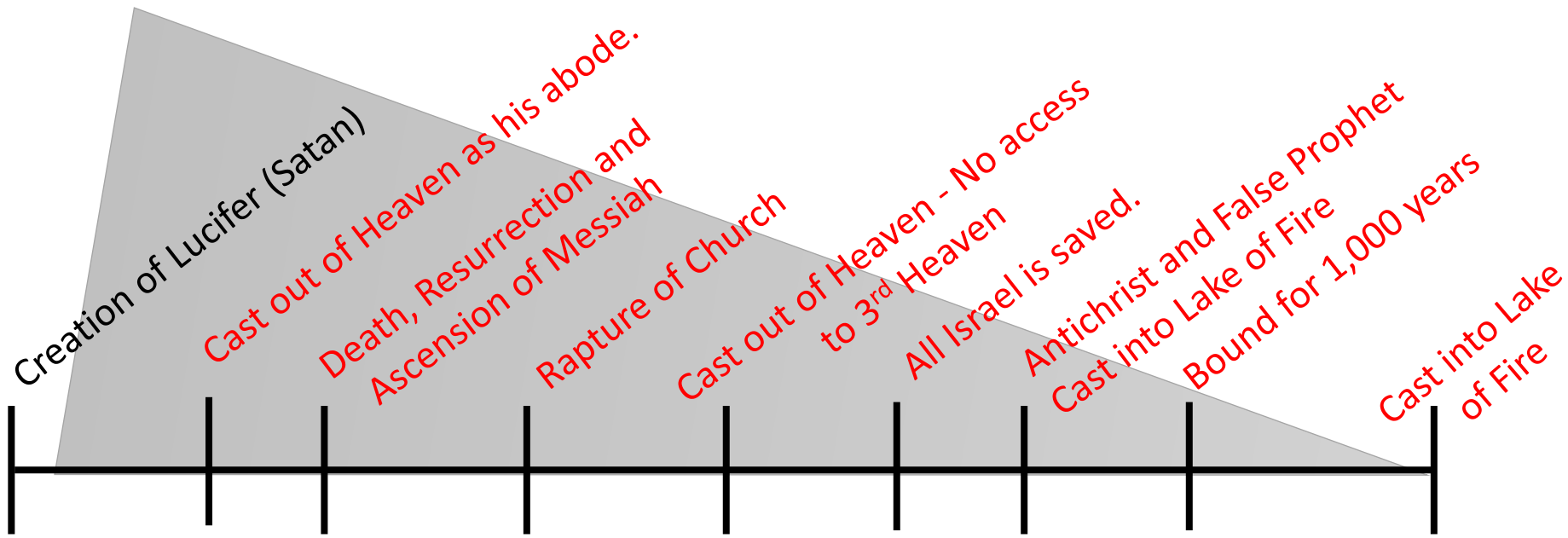

God is in control -

- God gave the angel the authority to throw Satan into the Abyss.
- God provided the means of releasing Satan from the pit.
- God allows him to pull off his deception.
- God allows Satan to gather the rebels against His people and against His land and against His city and then God destroys them.
- God grabs Satan and tosses him into the Lake of Fire already inhabited by the Antichrist and False Prophet.
- God makes sure there will be no end to their torment.

Therefore -

- Satan always functions within the sovereignty of God.
- Satan always functions within the stated purpose and goal of God in His plan for time and eternity.

This completes what was begun in Rev. 6 – the taking back of the absolute rule of God on earth as well as all of the universe, which was usurped by Satan in his fall and in the Garden of Eden.
