



Rev 21:1-4

- 1 Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and there is no longer any sea.
- 2 And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband.
- 3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them,
- 4 and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away."

Rev 21:5-8

- 5 And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." And He said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true."
- 6 Then He said to me, "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give to the one who thirsts from the spring of the water of life without cost.
- 7 "He who overcomes will inherit these things, and I will be his God and he will be My son.
- 8 "But for the cowardly and unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part will be in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new."

• In the eternal state, there will be a perpetual state of newness. Everything will always be fresh. Nothing will grow old. Nothing will wear out. The New Heavens and Earth will be a radical change from what we experience now.

The book of Revelation tells us that on us there is a *new name* in us, a *new song* around us, a *new Jerusalem* under us, a *new earth* over us, a *new heaven* before us, and always *new revelations* of God being given to us.

- In the eternal state, there will be a perpetual state of newness. Everything will always be fresh. Nothing will grow old. Nothing will wear out. The New Heavens and Earth will be a radical change from what we experience now.
- Your new place is being prepared for you, therefore you can begin making plans now. How?

Matt 6:20

20 "But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal;

Your salvation is a microcosm of what God will do on a grander scale with the new heavens and the new earth.

2 Cor 5:17

17 Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

And He said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true."

- Notice God tells John to "Write . . "
- "faithful and true" puts extra emphasis on what is about to be said.

"Then He said to me, "It is done."

"It is done" - $\gamma\iota\nu\circ\mu\alpha\iota$ – ginomai – perfect tense – "the task is complete and there are ongoing results." The new heavens and earth have been created with the result that a new home for the redeemed is now ready.

There is another major "completion" in Scripture - John 19:30

- 30 Therefore when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.
- "It is finished" $\tau\epsilon\lambda\epsilon\omega$ teleo perfect tense "it is accomplished with ongoing results." The final sacrifice for sin has been accomplished and salvation has been made available to all.

What was finished?

Forgiveness of sin.

1 Cor 15:3

3 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,

- God is the A to Z and everything in between.
- This title expresses His eternality and infinity.
- God is without beginning or end.
- There is none before Him and there is no one after Him.
- He is not bound by time, but is the cause of time.
- God is infinite. He is without measure. He is not bound by or limited to space.
- Among the Jewish rabbis, it was common to use the first and the last letters
 of the Hebrew alphabet to denote the whole of anything, from beginning to
 end.
- Everything comes from God and nothing will outlast God.
- God has the first word and the last word in history.
- All other attempts to have the last word will fail.
- The pottery has no beginning apart from the Potter, and in the end it will all serve the purposes of the Potter.

- Everything that exists, originates ultimately in Him. And everything ends with Him.
- At the end of every road is God. You will meet Him as light and life or as fire and torment.
- In reality all roads do lead to God. And when every man gets to God, the never-ending ω for every man, God will either be a loving Savior ushering you into the New Heavens and the New Earth or a wrathful judge ushering you into the Lake of Fire, but everyone will find their way to God.
- God never chose to be this way, nor did anyone else choose to make him this way. This is just Who He is from eternity.
- As Alpha, God did not emerge out of many possibilities. Everything emerged out of him.
- He determines all possibilities.
- Before him there was nothing.
- There was no "before him."
- For trillions upon trillions of unending years, God existed and never had a beginning. He *is* the beginning. There never was a time when he was not.

In eternity past God knew all possible plans -



Plan that would bring Him the most glory - most fully display His attributes.

- ullet Between the lpha and the lpha God has dealt with man on the basis of His:
- **Sovereignty** His ultimate, self-determining rule of the universe.
- Providence Providence is the outworking and demonstration of God's sovereignty. God, from eternity past, has appointed and directed all events and actions to accomplish the predetermined goal of the manifestation of His glory. These events and actions are brought to pass precisely at the exact time, by the exact means, and under the exact conditions, which God has determined.
 - God works through the streams of "confluence" and "concurrence" in the working of His providence.
 - **Confluence** a flowing together (2 or more streams or rivers).
 - Concurrence happening at the same time, cooperating, agreeing, meeting at the same point.
- Therefore all events take place in which the work of providence has been acted out through human agencies i.e. at the same time human agents are acting, God is acting in and through them.

Contingencies - events that could conceivably occur, or not occur.

- Something that can occur only when something else happens first. When an event or situation is contingent, it means that it depends on some other event or fact.
- 1. Nothing happens contingently in God's plan. God doesn't say, "If man would possibly do this, then I'll react and do this."
- 2. God knows all possible contingencies, but knows nothing contingently. He doesn't operate on the basis of contingents.
- 3. God's knowledge and actions are not dependent on what we will do.
- 4. God knows the end from the beginning. He knows us inside and out. He knows what we are going to say before we say it and He knows everything we possibly could say.
