



- This city has one gigantic purpose and that is to radiate the glory of God to radiate the glory of God.
- This purpose is no different than His plan from eternity past, and that is to display His glory.
- Whether it is His plan or His city, it is all about Him.
- As you look at the structure of this city and its materials and components, remember what it is designed to do – radically display the brilliance of God's glory.
- Therefore the design and materials must not impede or stifle in any way that brilliance.



- Jasper is all that John knew so he uses the comparative "as a . . ."
- This is a gem. It is crystal-clear. It is flawless.
- What John is seeing here is like a diamond.
- Diamonds were not discovered until 1,200 AD.
- It does not have light shining on it, but light shining from it.
 It is a ginormous diamond shooting out rays of light everywhere.

- Walls around a city, in Bible times, were important for the protection of a city. Average: 40 ft. high, 8 feet thick. Nineveh's walls were 50 feet thick.
- However the New Jerusalem will not need protection.
- So what is the purpose of the walls around the New Jerusalem?
 - 1. To reflect and refract the light of the glory of God.
 - 2. To remind the saints of life in a city which needs no protection.




The gates of a city were also very significant.

- The vulnerability and strength of a fortress or stronghold always rested in its gates. Whoever controlled the gates controlled the city.
- The gates of ancient cities were important as a means of providing access to the city while maintaining security.
- The gates were shut at nightfall (Joshua 2:5).
- They were the chief point at which an enemy would attack (Judges 5:8).
- Idolatrous acts were performed at the gates (Acts 14:13).
- Battering rams were set against the gates (Ezekiel 21:22)
- Gates were broken down and burned with fire(Nehemiah 1:3).
- The gates were seats of authority (Ruth 4:11).
- At the gates wisdom was spoken(Proverbs 1:21).
- Judges and officers served at the gates administering justice. (Deuteronomy 16:18)
- City councils were held at the gates (2 Chronicles 18:9).
- God's Word was read at the gates (Nehemiah 8:2-3).
- The prophets proclaimed God's message from the gates. (Jeremiah 17:19-20)
- The people also had to enter through the gates to worship the Lord. (Ps. 100:4)



- And they are a reminder that entrance into the city is because of Israel –





Where is Mary?

On the gates of New Jerusalem are the names of the twelve tribes of Israel (Rev. 21:12). On its twelve foundations are the names of the twelve apostles (Rev. 21:14). In the city itself are the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb as its temple (Rev 21:22), but Mary is NOT mentioned at all! Mary's name is not found in any of those locations, nor is she alluded to even in a tertiary way, including as its temple. All this is shockingly different than the way Catholicism has exalted her and given Mary the status of being sinless, sovereign, the hope of sinners, our refuge, the new ark of the covenant, the way to God and more. The Mary of Catholicism is a myth and has become, for the misinformed, a DANGEROUS **SNARE TO THEIR SOULS!**





- "miles" $\sigma \tau \alpha \delta_{10V}$ each is equivalent to 400 cubits or 1/8 mile. The dimension is equivalent to 4,800,000 cubits or approximately 1,500 miles.
- One furlong is 582 feet. Multiply 582 by 12,000, then divide by 5,280 feet in one mile, and you will get the exact size of the city - I,500 miles long, 1,500 miles wide, 1,500 miles high.

- A cube-shaped city rather than a pyramid would make the most sense as the Holy of Holies in Solomon's temple(1 Kings 6:20) was shaped like a cube.



- The New Jerusalem is larger than India with nearly 2 million square miles.
- It would have a diameter larger than the moon.
- It is 5 times higher than our space satellites which orbit the earth about 300 miles above the surface of the earth.
- If a building in the city is this high and has a generous 12 feet per story, the building would be over 600,000 stories high!
- If you are 1 mile away from the city, you would not see the top but might if you are 10 miles away.
- Henry Morris calculated that each believer would have a "block" with about 75 acres to call their own.

"To grasp something of the enormity of the city, consider that this figure is 40 times the area of England, 20 times that of New Zealand, and 10 times the area of Germany or France. The ground floor alone would provide enough living space for far more people than have ever lived in the history of the world. And this is just the first floor." "Never of course was there a city like this! If it were to be superimposed upon the United States, its area would cover all the way from Canada to the Gulf of Mexico, and from the Atlantic Ocean to Colorado."
