- John makes a point that these measurements are given according to human measurements, which are also angelic measurements.
- So in other words these are real literal measurements. A foot equals a foot and a mile equals a mile, whether you are man or angel.


"The material of the wall was jasper;"

- Jasper, as in verse 9, is diamond.
- These are diamond walls, all 4 of them, 1,500 miles high.

"and the city was pure gold, like clear glass."

- Gold is not clear, it is opaque.
- I haven't seen it and you haven't seen it. It is totally different.
- Why is it clear? To maximally radiate the glory of God. That is the purpose and design of the city.
- You can't have anything blocking it.
- The walls are totally transparent to cause all of the color of gold to reflect and refract all of the light from the glory of God into every possible space throughout the entire universe.
- Gold, by the way, is the representation of God's righteousness.
- New Jerusalem is a diamond set in gold for the glory of the Lord.

- 7) Chrysolyte golden yellow
- 8) Beryl sea green
- 9) Topaz greenish yellow
- 10) Chrysoprasus golden green
- 11) Jacinth reddish-orange
- 12) Amethyst purple






Why pearls?

1. Being made of pearl speaks of great value.

45 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking fine pearls,

46 and upon finding one pearl of great value, he went and sold all that he had and bought it.

Every time the saints will see the gates of pearl they will be reminded of 2 things:

- 1. The great value of their salvation.
- 2. Jews and Gentiles are both the people of God by the declared righteousness given at salvation in the Lord Jesus Christ.

2. Oysters, which produce pearls, were considered unclean under Levitical law.

Lev 11:10

10 'But whatever is in the seas and in the rivers that does not have fins and scales among all the teeming life of the water, and among all the living creatures that are in the water, they are detestable things to you,

But were made clean by a declaration of God . . .

Acts 10:9-15

9 On the next day, as they were on their way and approaching the city, Peter went up on the housetop about the sixth hour to pray.

- Note that it does not say streets (plural).
- Maybe there will only be one street that winds and winds and winds its way around the 1,500 mile cubed city.
- Or maybe John only saw 1 street from his vantage point and there are really millions of golden miles of streets.
- Again it is gold and it is transparent allowing all of the glory of God to shine through in its brilliance.

- 22 in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.




- 16 Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

Date To Be Built: Beginning of the Tribulation by

Israel - granted by the Antichrist.

Date Destroyed: Mid-point of the Tribulation by

the Antichrist.

Scripture: Dan. 9:24-27, Matt. 15, 2 Thess. 2:4,

Rev. 11:1,2

"for the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb are its temple."
New Jerusalem Temple

- There will be no building.
- God and His Son are its temple.
 - Notice the descriptive words –
 - "Almighty" a reference to God's sovereignty and might, as well as His command of powerful force.
 - "Lamb" the name 'Lamb' ($\alpha\rho\nu\iota\sigma\nu$, literally means 'little lamb') is used to refer to the sacrifice of Christ on the cross for our sins.
 - So God dwells in us (we are His temple) and we dwell in God (He is our temple). We have a combination of OT and NT temples combined or coming together into 1 temple – God and His Son. We will live in the temple of God and the Lord Jesus.

Date To Be Built: Beginning of the Millennium.

Date Destroyed: End of the millennium with

the creation of the new heavens and the new earth.

Scripture: Ez. 40-48, Rev. 21:22

- God and His Son will occupy every square inch of the new creation.
- God won't dwell upon a mercy seat behind the veil.
- Worship therefore will be everywhere.
 - There will be no need for anyone to go anywhere to worship God.
 - There won't be any place where they'll be having worship services.
 - There won't be any need for a day of worship.
 - Your whole life, which will be free of sin, will be a life of continual, unending worship. There will never be a moment when you're not in perfect fellowship with Him.

- the city had no need of the light from the sun or the moon because of the Shekinah glory of God which shines and extends out from the heart of the city throughout the entire universe.
- God created light on the first day, but the sun and moon were not created until the fourth day.

Gen 1:3-5

3 Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

4 God saw that the light was good; and God separated the light from the darkness.

5 God called the light day, and the darkness He called night.

Gen 1:14-16

14 Then God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night, and let them be for signs and for seasons and for days and years;

15 and let them be for lights in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth"; and it was so.

16 God made the two great lights, the greater light to govern the day, and the lesser light to govern the night;

No need of sun and moon -

Isa 24:23

23 Then the moon will be abashed (embarrassed) and the sun ashamed,

For the Lord of hosts will reign on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem,

And His glory will be before His elders.

Isa 60:19

19 "No longer will you have the sun for light by day, Nor for brightness will the moon give you light; But you will have the Lord for an everlasting light, And your God for your glory.

**The sun and moon in comparison with the light of the glory of God will be like turning on an outdoor light in the broad light of the sun.

"for the glory of God has illumined it,"

- when God concentrates all of His attributes to that which is manifest or visible, it comes out as light. It comes out as His glory.
- God expresses Himself in unhindered, unobstructed light.

"and its lamp is the Lamb"-

John 1:4

4 In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men.

John 8:12

12 Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, "I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life."

1 John 1:5

5 This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.

"The nations will walk by its light,"

- "nations" $\epsilon\theta\nu\eta$ the diversity of people that are saved from every tribe, tongue, people, and nation. (Rev. 5:9; 13:7; 14:6).
- This indicates that nations will exist in the New Earth.
- How a nation will be determined is not said. Nor its location or citizens.
- Everyone will be sinless, justified, sanctified, and glorified, regardless of ethnicity, culture, language, descent, or race. Everyone is welcome!
- But they will all be unified and will walk in the light.

1 John 1:6-7

6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth;

7 but if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another

"and the kings of the earth will bring their glory into it."

- "kings" those who will reign and rule over the nations.
- They are in those positions because of their faithful service while alive on the old earth.

Matt 25:21

21 "His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful slave. You were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things;

"In the daytime (for there will be no night there) its gates will never be closed;"

• In Bible times you never, ever left the gates of a city open, especially at night.

2 reasons:

- 1. At night it is dark and you cannot see what is outside of the gates.
- 2. It is the time an enemy would want to attack.
- In the capital city there are no enemies and it will never be dark, therefore leave them open.

• It was the ancient practice for kings and nations to bring their wealth and glory to the greatest king.

2 Chron 32:22-23

22 So the Lord saved Hezekiah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem from the hand of Sennacherib the king of Assyria and from the hand of all others, and guided them on every side.

23 And many were bringing gifts to the Lord at Jerusalem and choice presents to Hezekiah king of Judah, so that he was exalted in the sight of all nations thereafter.

Isa 60:11

11 "Your gates will be open continually;

They will not be closed day or night,

So that men may bring to you the wealth of the nations,

With their kings led in procession.

*Their will be a constant flow of kings and nations coming through the gates of the city to bring their honor and praise to the highest King – the King of Kings.

"and nothing unclean, and no one who practices abomination and lying,"

- "unclean" is a continual state. You are not "clean' until God declares you "clean."
- Similarly, there are those who "practice" (a continual action) abomination and lying.

"shall ever come into it,"

- "ου μη" strongest negative "never ever", "no possible way."
- The ultimate in security from any sin, wickedness and evil.
- What do you allow in through the "gates of your life?"

- The Book of Life is the eternal record of those who are saved for eternity.
- The names were written in it before the world was created in eternity past and the same names are there after the world is gone in eternity future.
