"And the kings of the earth, who committed acts of immorality and lived sensuously with her, will weep and lament over her when they see the smoke of her burning, (Rev. 18:9,10)

3 groups of people mourn the destruction of the city of Babylon:

1. Kings.

"kings" – national leaders under the Antichrist.

"acts of immorality and lived sensuously" — is a way of expressing the passion, the emotion, the close intimate relationship they had with Babylon politically and economically. They shared in her power and control over the people which brought them pleasure and luxury.

"weep and lament"

weep - $\kappa\lambda\alpha\iota\omega$ – to wail aloud, to sob.

lament – κοπτω – to mourn, to beat the breast in grief.

- "smoke of her burning" her destruction by fire happened quickly, and now all that is left is the smoke.
- They realize that everything they have is now gone because the capitol city that produced it is gone.
- They have refused to weep over their own sin, but now weep over the destruction of Babylon. Babylon and the profit and pleasure that it brings them, is indeed their god.

"And every shipmaster and every passenger and sailor, and as many as make their living by the sea, stood at a distance," (Rev. 18:17)

- 3. Ship captains, passengers, sailors, and those who work at sea.
- This is a disaster for them.
- Shipping, airline, railroad, and trucking industries collapse. They come to a standstill. It's over.
- They were the leaders in trafficking the luxurious and splendid commodities that the merchants were pushing.
- Babylon was the distribution and transportation center of the world. Now there is nothing more to distribute, nothing more to transport.

"And the merchants of the earth weep and mourn over her, because no one buys their cargoes any more — (Rev. 18:11)

2. Merchants.

"merchants" - businessmen, world traders, Corp. CEO's, marketers, powerbrokers.

• This is a different system than ch. 17 which was religious Babylon. Here, they are not lamenting the loss of religion but cargoes of luxurious goods.

"weep and mourn over her,"

Again no mourning over sin.

Rev 11:4-10

- 4 These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands that stand before the Lord of the earth.
- 5 And if anyone wants to harm them, fire flows out of their mouth and devours their enemies; so if anyone wants to harm them, he must be killed in this way.
- 6 These have the power to shut up the sky, so that rain will not fall during the days of their prophesying; and they have power over the waters to turn them into blood, and to strike the earth with every plague, as often as they desire.
- 7 When they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes up out of the abyss will make war with them, and overcome them and kill them.
- 8 And their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city which mystically is called Sodom and Egypt, where also their Lord was crucified.
- 9 Those from the peoples and tribes and tongues and nations will look at their dead bodies for three and a half days, and will not permit their dead bodies to be laid in a tomb.
- 10 And those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them and celebrate; and they will send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth.

- 11 But after the three and a half days, the breath of life from God came into them, and they stood on their feet; and great fear fell upon those who were watching them.
- 12 And they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, "Come up here." Then they went up into heaven in the cloud, and their enemies watched them.
- 13 And in that hour there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell; seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake, and the rest were terrified and gave glory to the God of heaven.

The format of Psalm 119 is an alphabetic acrostic, meaning that the first letters of each verse in Hebrew follow through the alphabet, 8 verses per letter, thus 8 verses x 22 letters in Hebrew alphabet = 176 verses.

Why was it written as an alphabetic acrostic? To show completeness and totality. God's Word covers everything from A-Z. Nothing more is needed. It is sufficient for all of life.

God and the Lord Jesus – They are the Alpha and the Omega – the A-Z - the beginning and the end. There is no more and nothing more is needed.

The Word of God – is the Aleph and the Tav – the A-Z – the beginning and the end. There is no more revelation and nothing more is needed.



*This is intimacy with God - His love letter to us.

"People say, "God told me to do this," and if you ask them how they know God told them to do this, their answer has absolutely nothing to do with the plain teaching of Scripture or a clear application of Scripture. This is something that has troubled Christians throughout the ages.

It is at that point that I always try to say: "You know, if God doesn't say it clearly in the Word or by the implication of the Word, you need to be very cautious about attributing to God a thought that has come into your mind. As some people attribute those thoughts to God just because they came unexpectedly without thinking, all kind of thoughts come unexpectedly to you. So it's always safe to stick to Scripture and so to grow in Scripture that you do actually develop, I think, instincts."

John Newton has a lovely way of putting this. He says, eventually, when your mind is saturated in Scripture, you develop the kind of instincts that a pianist has to be able to play the piano without stopping and thinking where they are going to put their fingers. And this is because your whole way of thinking is through spectacle lenses that are prescribed by Scripture."

Providence of God - "God, from eternity past, appoints and directs all events and actions to accomplish the predetermined goal of the display of His glory. These events and actions are brought to pass precisely at the exact <u>time</u>, by the exact <u>means</u>, and under the exact <u>conditions</u>, which God has determined. Providence reaches from the least detail in life to the greatest occurrence."

20 But the prophet who speaks a word presumptuously in My name which I have not commanded him to speak, or which he speaks in the name of other gods, that prophet shall die.

- 8 Therefore, thus says the Lord GOD, "Because you have spoken falsehood and seen a lie, therefore behold, I am against you," declares the Lord GOD.
- 9 "So My hand will be against the prophets who see false visions and utter lying divinations. They will have no place in the council of My people, nor will they be written down in the register of the house of Israel, nor will they enter the land of Israel, that you may know that I am the Lord GOD.

False claims of inspired revelation were a massive problem in the O.T.

Deut. 13:1-5

- 1 If a prophet or a dreamer of dreams arises among you and gives you a sign or a wonder,
- 2 and the sign or the wonder comes true, concerning which he spoke to you, saying, 'Let us go after other gods (whom you have not known) and let us serve them,'
- 3 you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams; for the LORD your God is testing you to find out if you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.
- 4 You shall follow the LORD your God and fear Him; and you shall keep His commandments, listen to His voice, serve Him, and cling to Him.
- 5 But that prophet or that dreamer of dreams shall be put to death, because he has counseled rebellion against the LORD your God who brought you from the land of Egypt and redeemed you from the house of slavery, to seduce you from the way in which the LORD your God commanded you to walk. So you shall purge the evil from among you.

Ez. 22:28

28 Her prophets have smeared whitewash for them, seeing false visions and divining lies for them, saying, 'Thus says the Lord GOD,' when the LORD has not spoken.
