



The next time God will speak will be through John the Baptist.


Ruling world.

Babylon - 612 BC - 539 BC

Persia - 539 BC -330 BC Malachi ends in 425 BC

Greece - 330 BC – 63 BC Language, educational systems, ways of commerce.

 Maccabee's - 166 BC - 63 BC 168 BC Judas Maccabee led a revolt against Antiochus Epiphanes IV Later the Hasmonean dynasty was established.



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II. Religious world.

• God's preparing of his people for the Messiah from the revelation given in the O.T., is complete. God has said all He has to say.

Israel -

The Septuagint - 250-125 BC – Greek translation of the OT for the use by the Greek speaking world. 72 men worked on it.

The Targum - translation of Heb. Scriptures into Aramaic.

The Talmud - comments on the Law by the Rabbis. Contains the Mishna, the Gemara and the Midrash. Comments on the comments.

Apocrypha - 11-17 books written during the 400 years.

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Rome - 63 BC – 476 AD Brought peace. Systematized the land, Roman roads. Soldiers by the roads. Safety at sea – no pirates.

10 reasons why we reject the Apocrypha as canonical Scripture:

- 1. The Apocrypha has different doctrine and practices than Holy Scripture.
- 2. The Apocrypha is never cited In the New Testament as Scripture.
- 3. The Apocrypha has always been rejected by the Jews as Scripture.
- 4. The books ff the Apocrypha were written during the Silent Years.
- 5. The Apocrypha is not a well-defined unit
- 6. The Apocrypha contains historical errors and contradictions.
- 7. The early church, when putting the cannon together, did not have the Apocrypha books on any canonical list for consideration.
- 8. None of the books in the Apocrypha claim Divine authority.
- 9. Jesus never quoted from the Apocrypha.
- 10. The content of the Apocrypha lacks the level of theological integrity that is contained in the rest of Scripture.

II. Religious world.

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Pseudepigrapha - "False writings" – books – Assumption of Moses, Ascension of Isaiah, Book of Enoch, Book of Jubilee, etc.

The Sanhedrin - Jewish "Supreme Court" ruling over civil and religious matters. 70 members who presided over the high priests.

The Pharisees - conservatives who came out of the Maccabees (who had become Hellenized). So they became separatists.

The Sadducees - Hellenized, aristocratic Jews. Greek lovers. Liberal. Guardians of the Temple policies and practices. Only accepted the Torah. No resurrection, final judgment, the supernatural or after life. Opposed the Pharisees but teamed with them against Jesus.

The Scribes – interpreters of the Law.

The Rabbis – teachers of the Law.

The Essenes - Came out of the Pharisees. Took the position of isolation from Hellenism. These were ultra-separatists. Moved to the caves around the Dead Sea.

The Synagogue – replaced the Temple during the Bab. Captivity. Met in homes. Later in buildings set aside for worship and instruction. and continues to this present day.

Why 4 Gospels?

- 1. To present to the world the testimony of 4 witnesses to the life and ministry of Jesus the Messiah and Savior of the world.
- 2. To present 4 different views from 4 different personalities, backgrounds, jobs, and walks of life.
- 3. To present the evidence and the gospel to 4 different groups of people:
 - A. Matthew Jews Presented as King.
 - B. Mark Romans Presented as Servant.
 - C. Luke Gentiles Presented as the Son of Man.
 - D. John World Presented as the Son of God.
