Luke 8:1,4

- 1 Soon afterwards, He began going around from one city and village to another, proclaiming and preaching the kingdom of God.
- 4 When a large crowd was coming together, and those from the various cities were journeying to Him,

• Note: Jesus gives a command:

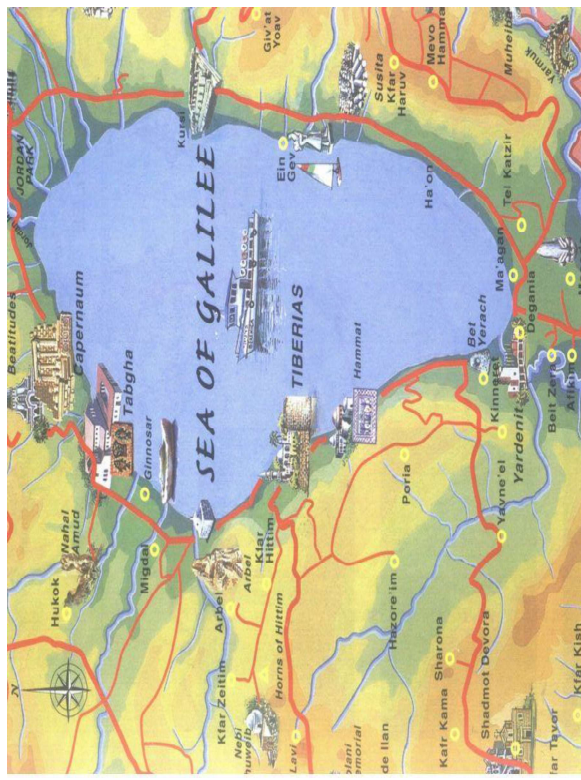
- The disciples obey.
- Jesus gets in the boat with them.
- There is more than 1 boat.

Mark 4:35-37

35 On that day, when evening came, He said to them, "Let us go over to the other side."

36 Leaving the crowd, they took Him along with them in the boat, just as He was; and other boats were with Him.

- In Jesus' day, the western shore of the Sea of Galilee was the Jewish side, while the eastern shore was the side where the Gentile cities were.
- Those on the east were considered "the other side".

- This is proof of His humanity.
- Peaceful at this point.
- But it soon changes from calm to a storm.
- How come so fast?

- No doubt Jesus is exhausted so He “crashes.”
- This is proof of His humanity.
- Peaceful at this point.
- But it soon changes from calm to a storm.
- How come so fast?
- **Think about it:** The Sea of Galilee, with all of its peculiarities, was created by God to put on display the magnificence of His Son.
- **“fierce gale of wind”** – “mega seismos” – Matt. 8:24
- **Note the wording:** “descended.”
- So the Lord creates the storm to show He is greater than the storm.
- The boat is filling with water.

- The fishermen know what is happening.
- Panic is everywhere. They feel the strain of living in a fallen world.
- **Note:** It is good to feel the strain. We need "wind stress" to grow.
- "Lord, save us! We're going to drown!" (Matthew 8:25)
- "Master, Master, we're going to drown!" (Luke 8:24)
- "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?" (Mark 4:38)
- Obedience got them into the storm.
- Sometimes disobedience gets you into the storm.
- Jesus sleeping = humanity
- Jesus rebuking = Deity
- How would you have reacted?

1. They did not show faith –

3. Believing God is present everywhere and is always with us.

"Where is your faith?"

1. They did not show faith –

- Panic, desperation, fear, worry.

2. Faith is based on 3 pillars:

1. Trusting in the promises of God's Word.
2. Understanding God's sovereignty, providence, and power.

- sails? water in the boat? others in the boat?

2. **If you don't spend time with the Lord in the calm of life, you won't know how to trust Him in the storms of life.**

3. **You must prepare your heart for the storm.**

5. Sometimes Jesus doesn't calm the storm.

- John the Baptist
- Apostles
- What should we do if we trust in the Lord, but the boat sinks? We trust in the Lord Jesus as we go under. “We go down singing the doxology.”
- John Hus was burned at the stake for his faith, but he went out singing.
- Nicholas Ridley and Hugh Latimer were burned at the stake together.
- Hudson Taylor lost his beloved wife Maria as they both sought to take the gospel to inland China.
- John Paton and his wife went to the New Hebrides Islands as missionaries and he lost his wife and child to a tropical fever 3 months after their arrival on the islands.
