"For this reason . . ." — looks back at the parable — the guy is going to store up grain. No need to do that. God will take of you.

- Therefore "stop worrying". "worry" vss. 22,25,26,29
- There is a lot in this world you can worry about. Like Peter walking on the water.
- Greed and worry are closely connected. Greed can never get enough, worry is afraid it will never have enough
- Food and clothes necessities.

1 Tim 6:8

8 If we have food and covering, with these we shall be content.

- This is not saying we should have no savings for the future, that we should not buy insurance, that we should not concern ourselves with money matters. People say. "Just trust God and He will provide". That is treading on the grace of God. That's wreckless.
- There is a fine line between worry and concern.
- · Worry accomplishes nothing.
- Concern motivates us to accomplish something.

Stress worry, and anxiety produce:

Mental health problems

Cardiovascular disease

Skin and hair problems

Gastrointestinal problem

"Research clearly shows that stress deteriorates our immune systems; people under constant or high stress show lower T cell counts, essential for immune response. Stress has a definite affect on fertility. Prolonged stress has been shown to affect the brain, making a person less able to respond to future stress. And stress also is related to sudden heart failure."

Some thoughts on worry -

Worry is taking on more responsibility than God intended you to have.

Worry is interest paid on trouble before it comes due.

Worry is the darkroom where negatives are developed.

You are probably well into worry...

- 1. When the thing you are concerned about is the first thing you think about in the morning and the last thing you think about at night.
- 2. When you find yourself thinking about it during every spare moment.
- 3. When you find yourself bringing it up in every conversation you have.

• The world is living life on the bread level.

- 4 The ravens brought him bread and meat in the morning and bread and meat in the evening, and he would drink from the brook.
- They don't have jobs. They don't collect a paycheck. They don't own a business. They have no warehouses.
- But God feeds them.

- However birds don't sit around all day with their mouths open for God to drop a worm into it.
- They fly and search and scratch and pick and explore i.e. they work.
- I have never seen a bird "paralyzed" by worry "Where is my next meal going to come from?"

2 Thess 3:7-8

7 For you yourselves know how you ought to follow our example, because we did not act in an undisciplined manner among you,

8 nor did we eat anyone's bread without paying for it, but with labor and hardship we kept working night and day so that we would not be a burden to any of you;

10 if anyone is not willing to work, then he is not to eat, either.

- If God is faithful to the birds, and we are more valuable than the birds, then He will be more than faithful to us.
- Trash any ideas you have that we are just a step up from the animals.
- If you worry, you deny God's faithfulness.

5 Man's days are determined; you have decreed the number of his months and have set limits he cannot exceed.

- God determines everything about our birth and the day of our death.
- Worry changes nothing about those 2 events.
- Our days are determined. The only thing that we determine is the quality of the life we live and taking care of ourselves.

Illustration #2 – Flowers

- Lilies don't make their own clothes. You won't find them shopping in the clothing dept. at Nordstrom's. You won't find them behind a sewing machine making their petals and pistils.
- They don't have to do that. Why? Because God is the one who adorns them in all of their beauty.
- Solomon was the best dressed man in Israel.
- But compared to lilies, there is no comparison.

Illustration #2 – Flowers

- Vs. 28 Even the beauty of grass across a field or lawn, God clothes. But then it is burned up.
- Grass has a very short life span. It ends up in an oven or furnace for heat to cook or for warmth.
- If God is lavish in His provision for lilies and grass, that is here today and gone tomorrow, don't you think He is concerned about clothing you?
- Again, you are of far greater value than flowers or grass which are much lower than humans, and in particular, His children.

We learned that last week – "be rich toward God."

 So Jesus wants us to trust Him and not worry. Jesus wants you to settle the issue of worrying in our lives and "stop" doing it.

Rom 14:23

23 and whatever is not from faith is sin.

• Worrying is a sin.

"eagerly seek" - επιζητεω – to crave

- The pursuit of the world (unbelievers) is exactly that "How am I going to put food on the table and clothes on my back?"
- Unbelievers have no promises from God. They have no heavenly Father that guarantees that there will be provision for them tomorrow. It makes sense for them to worry. They are just trying to survive.
- Your heavenly Father not only has the power and the resources to provide these things for us but He knows you need them. How wonderful!! How blessed we are!! I don't need to inform Him – He already knows.

- If I am not to worry, if I am not to put the whole fucus of my life on "food and clothing" what do I pursue?
- So here is the logical conclusion: Pursue God.

Matt 6:33

33 "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

Here is a command and a promise = "Seek and I will add."

The contrast is very clear: His kingdom or the world.

- You can either pursue the things of God or pursue the things of the world.
- You can either be spiritually-minded or earthly-minded.
- You can either be in pursuit of holiness and righteousness or you can be in pursuit of material possessions.
- You can either care more about the souls of men or the savings account in your bank.
- You can either pursue fellowship with God or fellowship with the ungodly.
- You can either be in pursuit of the fruit of the Spirit or you can be in pursuit of the desires of the flesh.
- You can either invest your money for eternity or you can invest it in this temporal world.
- You can either proclaim God to the world or you can proclaim the desire for money and materialism.
- You can either glorify God with your life or you can exalt yourself.
- · You can either trust God or you can worry.

32 "Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has chosen gladly to give you the kingdom.

- We are a little, little flock.
- How much does He give us? The entire kingdom.

Rom 8:17

17 and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ,

- And He does this "gladly" (His good pleasure). No holding back, no reluctance.
- A kingdom full of joy, peace, righteousness, abundance, riches in Christ.

2 Cor 9:8

8 And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed;

Phil 4:19

19 And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

We are "filthy" rich.

"The poorest person is one whose only wealth is money."

"Money never made anyone rich.'

- God provides for you enough for you to give some of it away.
- Give to those less fortunate but give wisely.
- We invest in the "bank (bags, purses) of heaven." Pays eternal dividends. Great returns.
- The "bank of heaven" will never be robbed, it will never fail, there will never be a "run on the bank", it will never close, because its existence is guaranteed, not by the FDIC, but by the God of the universe. How much more safe could it be?

- Follow the money It will tell you the condition of your heart.
- The heart is the core of life your thoughts, your will, it is what you are.
- John Rascus put \$300 in the collection plate when it passed, and he said softly, "I'll see you in heaven."

I'd rather have Jesus than silver or gold, I'd rather be His than have riches untold; I'd rather have Jesus than houses or lands, I'd rather be led by His nail-pierced hands.

If you have Jesus you have everything. No need to worry!
