Luke 21:5-9

- 5 And while some were talking about the temple, that it was adorned with beautiful stones and votive gifts, He said,
- 6 "As for these things which you are looking at, the days will come in which there will not be left one stone upon another which will not be torn down."
- 7 They questioned Him, saying, "Teacher, when therefore will these things happen? And what will be the sign when these things are about to take place?"

- 9 "When you hear of wars and disturbances, do not be terrified; for these things must take place first, but the end does not follow immediately."


- If you are consistent and faithful in <u>literally</u> interpreting the Bible, then you will get Israel's covenants and promises right . . .

- If you get the Church and Israel right, then you get prophecy right.



- A major theme of the Tribulation will be war rumors and the actual wars themselves.



During the Tribulation many will be slaughtered for their faith in Christ -

Rev 7:13-14

13 Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "These who are clothed in the white robes, who are they, and where have they come from?"

14 I said to him, "My lord, you know." And he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Rev 13:7-10

7 It was also given to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them, and authority over every tribe and people and tongue and nation was given to him.

8 All who dwell on the earth will worship him, everyone whose name has not been written from the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb who has been slain.

9 If anyone has an ear, let him hear.

10 If anyone is destined for captivity, to captivity he goes; if anyone kills with the sword, with the sword he must be killed. Here is the perseverance and the faith of the saints.

Rev 14:6-7

6 And I saw another angel flying in midheaven, having an eternal gospel to preach to those who live on the earth, and to every nation and tribe and tongue and people;

- Don't spend time on your testimony or memorizing the 4 spiritual laws.
- God will give you the words to say.
- Why? Because it will take wisdom to know how to respond in these situations.

Application

- 1. Though you may think at times that your world is collapsing around you, take comfort in knowing it is nothing like the Tribulation.
