
Questions That Demand an Answer



- 1. Where did the space for the universe come from?

- 5. Where did the energy come from to do all the organizing?
- 6. When, where, why, and how did life come from dead matter?
- 7. When, where, why, and how did life learn to reproduce itself?
- 8. With what did the first cell capable of sexual reproduction reproduce?

Intelligent Design

- Intelligent Design the belief that by studying the evidence in the universe from the stars down to the cell, the best and most logical explanation is that it was assembled by an intelligent designer.
- ID comes to this conclusion apart from Scripture. It only looks at science and the scientific data available.
- The belief therefore is a scientific one and not a religious one.
- ID is based on scientific evidence and reasoning.
- ID is saying to the evolutionist, "Your theory, based on the evidence, is impossible and makes no sense."
- ID's purpose is to get people to think. That thinking should bring people to a belief in an intelligent designer (God).

- It begins with the same 3 words "Then God said, . . ."
- It is no different than the past 5 ½ days. It will be instantaneous, by God speaking, and complete when finished.
- The next words however mark a great difference with past creative acts.

"Let us . . ." It is no longer God simply giving a command.

- It is now "we". Used 2 ways here:
- 1. Majestic plural though it may be coming from a singular person, it uses the pronoun "we." (Ex. "We don't do it that way around here." Only 1 person but uses "we."
- 2. First hint in Scripture of the Trinity. Will be developed more extensively in the NT.
- 3. It is the entire Godhead that came up with the plan.


Adam

- Meaning: A human being, a person, an individual, man, mankind.
- Man was created fully mature and functional like all of the plants, trees, animals, sea creatures, and birds. The entire universe was a totally fully functional universe right from the beginning.
- God did not plant seeds, or create eggs, or embryos, or babies.
 - 1. Trees had fruit and trees had rings.
 - 2. Animals were fully grown, not eggs or embryos.
 - 3. Stars had light already reaching the earth so they were able to be seen. Why can't God, not only create the stars and the earth but also create the light between the stars and the earth?
 - 4. Adam was not a baby or infant but an adult capable of reproduction, walking, talking and carrying on a conversation, reasoning, naming the animals and working in the garden.

If you examined Adam, you would say he was a mature adult. Perhaps 20-30 years old, even though he was created 5 minutes ago.


- Everything had the appearance of being mature.
- Adam didn't look old, just mature. Appearance of maturity.
- Example: Mt. St. Helens





May 18, 1980 - Erupted

- 540 million tons of ash and debris.
- Ash cloud carried ash to east coast.
- 100 layers of sediment formed in 3 hours 9 PM 12 midnight.
- Geologist went in after it was safe and tested the rocks with their instruments. What did they find? The rocks which had been formed only days earlier, were 340,000 to 2,800,000 years old.

The documented evidence is undeniable. Mount St. Helens revealed to the world that both thick and thin layering can happen fast. Sedimentary layers hundreds of feet thick formed within hours during the eruption itself, and then hardened into rock soon after the water drained from them."
