"DON'T BE TEMPTED TO GO BACK"

Heb. 5:1-6

Feb. 3, 2013

- 1 For every high priest taken from among men is appointed on behalf of men in things pertaining to God, in order to offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins;
- 2 he can deal gently with the ignorant and misguided, since he himself also is beset with weakness;
- 3 and because of it he is obligated to offer sacrifices for sins, as for the people, so also for himself.
- 4 And no one takes the honor to himself, but receives it when he is called by God, even as Aaron was.
- 5 So also Christ did not glorify Himself so as to become a high priest, but He who said to Him,
- "YOU ARE MY SON,
- TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU";
- 6 just as He says also in another passage,
- "YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER
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

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THE TABERNACLE



What did a High Priest do?

- Directed the work of the priests & Levites.
 (Numbers 3:4)
- Prayed on behalf of the people to the Lord (Judges 20:28)
- Consecrated the priests. (Exodus 29:1-37)
- Maintained the golden candlestand with its fire. (Lev. 24:1-4)
- Burned incense daily (Exodus 30:7-8), and in a special way on the Day of Atonement. (Leviticus 16:2, 12-13)
- Offered sacrifices on the Day of Atonement.
 (Hebrews 5:1; Leviticus 23:6, 11, 15, 20)

The Day of Atonement

On the Day of Atonement the regular daily offerings were made, plus:

- * A bullock for a sin offering for the priesthood
- * A ram for a burnt offering for the priesthood
- * Two goats for a sin offering for the people
- * A ram for a burnt offering for the people
- * One young bullock, one ram, seven lambs, with accompanying meal and drink offerings
- **On the Day of Atonement, the high priests took the blood of the sin offering made for himself (the bullock) into the Holy of Holies and sprinkled it on the Mercy Seat of the Ark. He then returned to the altar and took the blood of the goat offered for the sins of the congregation into the Holy of Holies and sprinkled it in the same manner.

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Num 15:28

28 The priest shall make atonement before the Lord for the person who goes astray when he sins unintentionally, making atonement for him that he may be forgiven.

2 kinds of sin in O.T. –

1. Sins of Ignorance

These are sins that are unintentional, "in error", and may have been committed through ignorance, hurry, lack of consideration, or carelessness, in other words, sins which came from human weakness. as opposed to sins which are deliberately and knowingly done in rebellion against God and His commandments.

Lev 4:1-3

- 1 Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying,
 2 "Speak to the sons of Israel, saying, 'If a person sins unintentionally in any of the
- things which the Lord has commanded not to be done, and commits any of them, 3 if the anointed priest sins so as to bring guilt on the people, then let him offer to the Lord a bull without defect as a sin offering for the sin he has committed.
- *For those who sinned in ignorance, there were two sacrifices. For the sins that he knew he committed, the daily sacrifices. For the ones that he didn't know he committed, the day of atonement took care of all of those.

2. Sins of Presumption

These are sins which are deliberately and knowingly done in rebellion against God and His commandments.

Num 15:30

30 'But the person who does anything presumptuously, whether he is native-born or a stranger, that one brings reproach on the Lord, and he shall be cut off from among his people.

Ps 19:13

13 Also keep back Your servant from presumptuous sins;

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John 8:54

54 Jesus answered, "If I glorify Myself, My glory is nothing; it is My Father who glorifies Me, of whom you say, 'He is our God';

O.T. High Priest

- Was a man
- Appointed to lead men to God.
- •Offered gifts and sacrifices for sins.
- •Gently, patiently, & yet firmly he deals with those who commit sins of ignorance and are repentant.
- Has weaknesses.
- •Offers sacrifices on behalf of the people.
- Offers sacrifices on behalf of himself.
- •His only honor is to be called by God.

<u>Jesus Christ – Our Great High Priest</u>

- Became a man.
- Came to lead men to God.
- •Offered Himself as a sacrifice for sin.
- •Gently, patiently, & yet firmly He deals with those who commit sins of ignorance and are repentant.
- •Has no weakness but is able to sympathize with us in temptation.
- •Offered Himself as a sacrifice for the sins of the people.
- •Did not have to offer Himself for Himself.
- Was glorified and honored by His calling by God to be an eternal High Priest.

Application

- 1. The Christian life is not complex it is about the embodiment of the entire Jewish system of the O.T. in to 1 person the High Priest of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2. Don't go back:
 - 1. Christ is the Person you are searching for.
 - 2. No ritualistic system will ever satisfy the longing and the needs of your soul.
- 3. The Lord Jesus Christ has instituted a new priestly order, not of a few select individuals, but of all those who are born again, who are united by faith with His priesthood called the Priesthood of Believers.

1 Peter 2:9

- 9 But you are A CHOSEN RACE, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR God's OWN POSSESSION, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;
- 4. Your priesthood allows you to enter God's presence at any time and from anywhere with boldness.
- Your priesthood places you in a position of standing between men and God in the sense that you can bring people to God through the proclamation of the gospel.
