Heb 6:1-8

- 1 Therefore leaving the elementary teaching about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God,







Eccl 12:14

God's Will

1 Will - 2 Dimensions

God's Determined Will - what He determines will happen.

(unrevealed in His Divine Decrees)

God's Desired Will - what He desires to happen.

(revealed in His Word)

Desired

Ex 5:1

"Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, "Let My people go that they may celebrate a feast to Me in the wilderness."

Determined

Ex 4:21

- 21 The LORD said to Moses, "When you go back to Egypt see that you perform before Pharaoh all the wonders
- which I have put in your power; but I will harden his heart so that he will **not let the people go**.

<u>Desired</u>

Ex 20:13

13 "You shall not murder.

Determined

Acts 2:23

23 this Man, delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put Him to death.

Acts 4:27-28

- 27 "For truly in this city there were gathered together against Your holy servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, along with the Gentiles and the peoples of Israel,
- 28 to do whatever Your hand and Your purpose predestined to occur.

- Principle: God wills the "greater good". It may be His desired will or it may not be.
- God determines for any given situation what will best put on display His divine attributes and therefore achieve His divine purposes.

- We exercise our wills the same way: "I really <u>want</u> a piece of French Silk pie, but I am <u>determined</u> to stick to my diet."
- "I really <u>desire</u> to go on a trip to Europe, but I am <u>determined</u> to save my money."
- "I don't <u>want</u> to punish you, but I have determined it is the <u>best</u> thing to do."

Application

- 1. The Bible teaching ministry of a local church must move forward. It can not slow down or continue to dumb down the teaching, and wait until everyone has matured to a certain point.
- 2. The Old Testament laid the foundation, and is beneficial in helping us understand the super structure of the New Testament.
- 3. The aim of our lives should be to do the desired will of God.
- 4. Express to God in prayer your desire to grow as far and deep as possible.
