3 reasons why I do not believe this passage is talking about a believer losing his/her salvation:

1. All of the language used in verses 4 ad 5 is never used anywhere else in scripture to describe salvation. There is no mention here of salvation, justification, being saved, being born again, justification, sanctification, glorification, regeneration, made holy, or made righteous.



2 Peter 2:20-22

- 7 For ground that drinks the rain which often falls on it and brings forth vegetation useful to those for whose sake it is also tilled, receives a blessing from God;
- 8 but if it yields thorns and thistles, it is worthless and close to being cursed, and it ends up being burned.

Application

- 1. The Holy Spirit is warning us here that if you get real close to becoming a believer, if you expose yourself to and observe what the Christian life is all about, if you think you are secure, but don't take the final step and believe and trust Christ for salvation, you are on unstable ground and you need to flee from it and move to solid ground.
- 2. If your life consists of living a life of "thorns" and "thistles" during the week, don't think your "tasting" on Sundays will survive the final judgment it won't!
- 3. When you have come so close and then you reject Christ and the way of salvation, and all that God promises us in Christ, and you turn your back on it and go after the "fleeting pleasures of this world", you are saying that they are worth more than Christ, and it will therefore be impossible for you to ever be saved, for there is no other way to God but through Christ.
- 4. If the author of Hebrews observed your life, which group would he put you in – the group with evidence that they are saved or would he put you in the group that has merely tasted?
- 5. There is eternal security for the true believer who has taken the step, crossed the line, and put his faith and trust in Christ alone for salvation. Praise God!!!
