Heb 6:13-20

- 13 For when God made the promise to Abraham, since He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself,
- 14 saying, "I WILL SURELY BLESS YOU AND I WILL SURELY MULTIPLY YOU."
- 15 And so, having patiently waited, he obtained the promise.
- 16 For men swear by one greater than themselves, and with them an oath given as confirmation is an end of every dispute.
- 17 In the same way God, desiring even more to show to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of His purpose, interposed with an oath,
- 18 so that by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us.
- 19 This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, a hope both sure and steadfast and one which enters within the veil,
- 20 where Jesus has entered as a forerunner for us, having become a high priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.

- 20 where Jesus has entered as a forerunner for us, having become a high priest (Goodness) forever (Eternality, Faithfulness) according to the order of Melchizedek.

- 1 As He passed by, He saw a man blind from birth.
- 2 And His disciples asked Him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he would be born blind?"
- 3 Jesus answered, "It was neither that this man sinned, nor his parents; but it was so that the works of God might be displayed in him.

James 1:13

13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, and He Himself does not tempt anyone.

Gen 50:20


20 "As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good

• For anything that occurs, God could have prevented it if He had wanted to.

• Therefore if God allows something, it is because it was part of His plan from the beginning.

 It can only be said therefore that God "permits" something to occur because He has purposed and planned it from eternity past.

Dualism




God has nothing to do with what Satan does. Satan operates independent from God. Satan does what he pleases. Man is often the helpless victim of the acts of Satan. Satan is very powerful and wins many battles but God wins in the end.

In Dualism:

- 1. The believer is led to attribute far more power to Satan than what he actually possesses.
- 2. The believer is subtlety led to believe that Satan is virtually equal to God.
- 3. The believer spends his life focused more on combat with the Devil than on seeing & trusting in the purposes of God.

Sovereign Monotheism



In Sovereign Monotheism:

- 1. God is infinitely greater than Satan.
- Satan can't make a move unless permission to do so is granted by God.
- 3. Satan is God's "puppet" used to carry out God's determined will.
- 4. The believer's life is focused on God's purposes in all things.

The Faith-Life of Abraham

• Abraham was promised a land.

Gen 12:1

2 Now the Lord said to Abram,

"Go forth from your country,

And from your relatives

And from your father's house,


To the land which I will show you;

Heb 11:8

8 By faith Abraham, when he was called, obeyed by going out to a place which he was to receive for an inheritance; and he went out, not knowing where he was going.

Gen 11:31-32

- 31 Terah took Abram his son, and Lot the son of Haran, his grandson, and Sarai his daughter-in-law, his son Abram's wife; and they went out together from Ur of the Chaldeans in order to enter the land of Canaan; and they went as far as Haran, and settled there.
- 32 The days of Terah were two hundred and five years; and Terah died in Haran.



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• Abraham was promised a nation and nations.

Gen 12:2

And I will make you a great nation,

And I will bless you,

And make your name great;

And so you shall be a blessing;

Gen 17:3-5

- 3 Abram fell on his face, and God talked with him, saying,
- 4 "As for Me, behold, My covenant is with you,
- And you will be the father of a multitude of nations.
- 5 "No longer shall your name be called Abram,
- But your name shall be Abraham;
- For I have made you the father of a multitude of nations.

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Rom 9:6-8

- 6 But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For they are not all Israel who are descended from Israel;
- 7 nor are they all children because they are Abraham's descendants, but: "THROUGH ISAAC YOUR DESCENDANTS WILL BE NAMED."
- 8 That is, it is not the children of the flesh who are children of God, but the children of the promise are regarded as descendants.

Abraham Physical Israel Spiritual Israel

Rom 4:3

3 For what does the Scripture say? "ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS."

Gal 3:6-7

- 6 Even so Abraham BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS RECKONED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS.
- 7 Therefore, be sure that it is those who are of faith who are sons of Abraham.

James 2:23

23 and the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "AND ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS RECKONED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS,"

Abraham was promised a son.

Gen 17:19

19 But God said, "No, but Sarah your wife will bear you a son, and you shall call his name Isaac; and I will establish My covenant with him for an everlasting covenant for his descendants after him.

• Abraham was promised a provision.

Gen 22:2

2 He said, "Take now your son, your only son, whom you love, Isaac, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I will tell you."

Heb 11:17-19

- 17 By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises was offering up his only begotten son;
- 18 it was he to whom it was said, "IN ISAAC YOUR DESCENDANTS SHALL BE CALLED."
- 19 He considered that God is able to raise people even from the dead, from which he also received him back as a type.


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Abraham –

- 1. Was promised a land Abraham believed.
- 2. Was promised a nation and nations Abraham believed.
- 3. Was promised a son Abraham believed.
- 4. Was promised a provision Abraham believed.

Gen 15:18-21


- 18 On that day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying,

- 9 So He said to him, "Bring Me a three year old heifer, and a three year old female goat, and a three year old ram, and a turtledove, and a young pigeon."

- 15 "As for you, you shall go to your fathers in peace; you will be buried at a good old age.
- 16 "Then in the fourth generation they will return here, for the iniquity of the Amorite is not yet complete."
- 17 It came about when the sun had set, that it was very dark, and behold, there appeared a smoking oven and a flaming torch which passed between these pieces.


