




Old Testament View of Future Prophetic Events







Comprehensive Biblical View of Future Prophetic Events







Apostasy at the End of the Church Age 1 Tim 4:1-5

- 1 But the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and doctrines of demons,
- 2 by means of the hypocrisy of liars seared in their own conscience as with a branding iron,
- 3 men who forbid marriage and advocate abstaining from foods which God has created to be gratefully shared in by those who believe and know the truth.
- 4 For everything created by God is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with gratitude;
- 5 for it is sanctified by means of the word of God and prayer.

2 Tim 3:1-5

- 1 But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come.
- 2 For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy,
- 3 unloving, irreconcilable, malicious gossips, without self-control, brutal, haters of good,

5 Step Progression to Apostasy

1. The Passion is Gone

Rev 2:1-4

- 1 "To the angel of the church in **Ephesus** write:
- The One who holds the seven stars in His right hand, the One who walks among the seven golden lampstands, says this:
- 2 "I know your deeds and your toil and perseverance, and that you cannot tolerate evil men, and you put to the test those who call themselves apostles, and they are not, and you found them to be false;
- 3 and you have perseverance and have endured for My name's sake, and have not grown weary.
- 4 "But I have this against you, that you have left your first love.

2. Compromise

Rev 2:12

- 12 "And to the angel of the church in **Pergamum** write:
- 14 "But I have a few things against you, because you have there some who hold the teaching of Balaam, who kept teaching Balak to put a stumbling block before the sons of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols and to commit acts of immorality.
- 15 "So you also have some who in the same way hold the teaching of the Nicolaitans.

3. Tolerance

Rev 2:18

18 "And to the angel of the church in **Thyatira** write:

20 "But I have this against you, that you tolerate the woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, and she teaches and leads My bond-servants astray so that they commit acts of immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols.

4. Apathy Rev 3:1-4

1 "To the angel of the church in **Sardis** write:

- He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars, says this: "I know your deeds, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead.
- 2 "Wake up, and strengthen the things that remain, which were about to die; for I have not found your deeds completed in the sight of My God.
- 3 "So remember what you have received and heard; and keep it, and repent. Therefore if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come to you.
- 4 "But you have a few people in Sardis who have not soiled their garments; and they will walk with Me in white, for they are worthy.

5. Dead and Worthless Rev 3:14-20

- 14 "To the angel of the church in **Laodicea** write:
- The Amen, the faithful and true Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God, says this:
- 15 "I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot.
- 16 "So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth.
- 17 "Because you say, "I am rich, and have become wealthy, and have need of nothing," and you do not know that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked,
- 18 I advise you to buy from Me gold refined by fire so that you may become rich, and white garments so that you may clothe yourself, and that the shame of your nakedness will not be revealed; and eye salve to anoint your eyes so that you may see.
- 19 "Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline; therefore be zealous and repent.
- 20 "Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and will dine with him, and he with Me.

2 Thess 2:7-12

- 7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only he who now restrains will do so until he is taken out of the way.
- 8 Then that lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord will slay with the breath of His mouth and bring to an end by the appearance of His coming;
- 9 that is, the one whose coming is in accord with the activity of Satan, with all power and signs and false wonders,
- 10 and with all the deception of wickedness for those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth so as to be saved.
- 11 For this reason God will send upon them a deluding influence so that they will believe what is false,
- 12 in order that they all may be judged who did not believe the truth, but took pleasure in wickedness.

"Restrainer"

Some have suggested that the "restrainer" is:

- Government
- Preaching the Gospel
- Binding Satan by believers
- Principle of morality
- Michael the archangel
- The Church

However none of these is able to restrain evil on a world wide basis. It would have to be a supernatural Person. It would have to be the Holy Spirit.

Ministries of the Holy Spirit His Ministry to the Unbeliever.

Convicting

John 16:8-11

8 "And He, when He comes, will **convict** the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment;

9 concerning sin, because they do not believe in Me;

10 and concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father and you no longer see Me; 11 and concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged.

His Ministry to the Believer at Salvation.

A. <u>Regenerating</u>

John 3:5-8

- 5 Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is **born** of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- 6 "That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is **born** of the Spirit is spirit.
- 7 "Do not be amazed that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'
- 8 "The wind blows where it wishes and you hear the sound of it, but do not know where it comes from and where it is going; so is everyone who is born of the Spirit."

B. <u>Baptizing</u>

1 Cor 12:13

13 For by one Spirit we were all **baptized** into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

C. Indwelling

Rom 8:9

9 However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.

John 14:17

17 that is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him, but you know Him because He abides with you and **will be in you**.

D. <u>Distributing</u>

1 Cor 12:4-11

- 4 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- 5 And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord.
- 6 There are varieties of effects, but the same God who works all things in all persons.
- 7 But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.
- 8 For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, and to another the word of knowledge according to the same Spirit;
- 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit,

- 10 and to another the effecting of miracles, and to another prophecy, and to another the distinguishing of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, and to another the interpretation of tongues.
- 11 But one and the same Spirit works all these things, **distributing** to each one individually just as He wills.

E. <u>Sealing</u>

Eph 1:13

13 In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation — having also believed, you were **sealed** in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise,

Eph 4:30

30 Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were **sealed** for the day of redemption.

His Ministry to the Believer during Sanctification.

A. Controlling

Eph 5:18

- 18 And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit,
- 19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord;
- 20 always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God, even the Father;
- 21 and be subject to one another in the fear of Christ.

Col 3:16-17

- 16 Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
- 17 Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

By controlling the believer the Holy Spirit:

A. Teaches us.

John 16:13

13 "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will **guide** you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

1 Cor 2:10-13

- 10 For to us God revealed them through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God.
- 11 For who among men knows the thoughts of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so the thoughts of God no one knows except the Spirit of God.
- 12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God,
- 13 which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those **taught** by the Spirit, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words.

Psalm 119:18

18 Open my eyes, that I may behold wonderful things from Your law.

B. Leads us.

Rom 8:14

14 For all who are being **led** by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

C. Assures us.

Rom 8:16

16 The Spirit Himself **testifies with our spirit** that we are children of God,

D. Prays on behalf of us.

Rom 8:26

26 In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself **intercedes for us** with groanings too deep for words;

E. Produces fruit in us.

Gal 5:22

- 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
- 23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

6. Empowers us to witness.

Acts 1:8

8 but **you will receive power** when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and **you shall be My witnesses** both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

Acts 4:31

31 And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all **filled** with the Holy Spirit and began to **speak the word of God with boldness.**
