





Application:

- 1. Though there is incredible chaos on the earth during the Tribulation, God is still on His throne (Rev. 4,5) and totally in control of the events that are happening (vs. 6 "for these things must take place"). Not one dust particle moves during the Tribulation unless He commands it.
- 2. As with Pharaoh (Rom. 9:17), so God will raise up and sustain the Antichrist to accomplish His purposes and glorify His name.
- 3. God uses natural means (wars, famines, disease, wild animals), and supernatural means (earthquakes, asteroids, comets, meteors, volcanoes, floods) to pour out His wrath upon the earth.
- 4. In judgment, God is no respecter of persons.
- 5. Death by tragedy is better than death by wrath.
